

2018 Statewide Watercraft Inspection & Decontamination Stations

Stations are listed in alphabetical order.

*Stations listed are issuing and accepting **green seals** from other state-authorized inspection locations. Seals will be issued upon the completion of inspections or decontaminations upon exiting reservoirs, CPW offices and private service providers. A green seal expedites the inspection process greatly, but boaters with seals still have to stop at the inspection station and have the seal verified by an inspector prior to launching. Remember to request your green seal when leaving your favorite lake or reservoir to ensure a quicker launch next time you boat!*
Clean, Drained and Dry boats go through inspection and get on the water much faster!

NOTE: In 2018, all ballast boats, Inboard and Inboard/Outboard engines must have a green seal in between launches or decontamination may take place prior to launching.
