<b>1</b>	<p><b>NEW REGULATIONS FOR BOATERS THAT AFFECT ANGLERS WERE NOT INCLUDED AT THE TIME OF THE PRINT PUBLICATION:</b></p> <p><b>THESE REGULATIONS ARE INCLUDED IN THE ONLINE VERSION ONLY.</b></p>	<p><b>» NEW BOATING REGULATIONS TO HELP CONTAIN AQUATIC NUISANCE SPECIES...</b> It is the responsibility of the vessel or other floating device operator to clean, drain water from all compartments and motors/engines in between launches and dry the vessel or other floating device in between launches.</p> <p>Upon removal of a vessel or other floating device from waters of the state, and before leaving the boat launch or parking area, the operator is required to remove aquatic plants and water drain plug(s). It is prohibited to transport a vessel or other floating device over land with aquatic plants or water drain plugs in place.</p>
