Join us for a hike through Chatfield State Park. We will get our legs and our minds moving as we check out some of the historical relevance Chatfield Park has to offer.

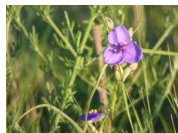
*Meet at the Platte River Parking lot.*

#### **PARKS PASSES**

A Colorado State Park Pass is required on all vehicles entering the park. Daily passes are \$8 per vehicle, annual passes are \$70 and are good for one year from the date of purchase at all 42 Colorado State Parks.
