

Dispersed Camping Within the River Corridor:

1. Bring a Portable Toilet Device
 - a. Must be emptied in compliance with the law
 - b. Toilet kit waste bags are sold at the AHRA Visitor Center
2. Use Fire Containers, Follow Fire Restrictions for the Area You are In
 - a. Fire containers must have at least a two-inch rigid side
 - b. Fire pan must be elevated off the ground
 - c. Always check for local fire restrictions before building a fire
 - d. Know what land you are recreating on and follow the rules for that area
3. Camping is limited to 14 days in any 28 day period

Developed Campgrounds in the AHRA

All developed campgrounds run by AHRA have vault toilets, tables, fire pits and DO NOT have electricity hookups, dumping, or water.

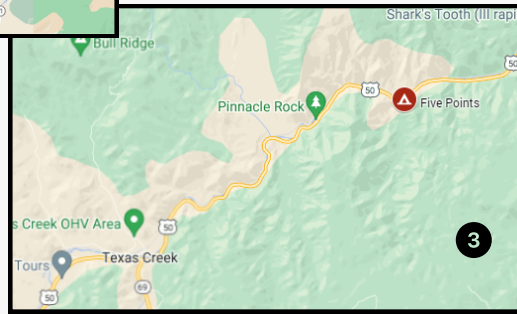
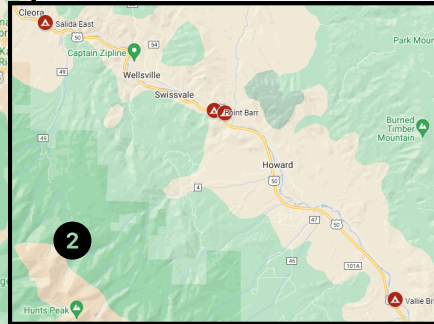
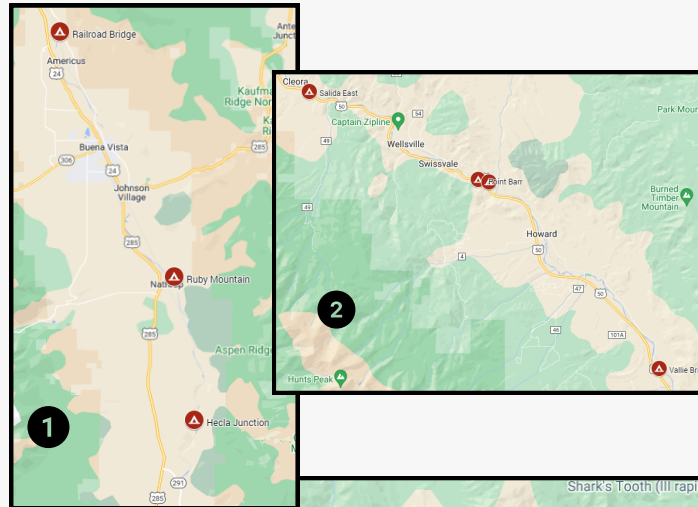
