VFMP

- Lowered anticipated imports to 52.9k acre feet (from 59k).
- Collection basin is currently at 100%.

- Upper basin is looking good.
- Request to separate Upper and Lower Basin in Snotel
- Request to educate journalists on what numbers mean instead of giving an entire state snowpack %
- Black Hills Property
 - City Council is still discussing ownership.
 - Mitigation/remediation is complete. A report has been given to Council with what's been done.
 - No determination yet on ownership of property.
- Recreational Ranger Program
 - Envision Chaffee County and Chaffee County are funding a position to help with dispersed/no-fee areas.
 - The pilot program went well, and we got good feedback from the Recreational Rangers.
 - BLM and USFS also have their own Rec Rangers.
 - Currently working with CMC on an internship program (internship would be unpaid)
 - Trying to give the option to transition into an apprenticeship program as Rec Rangers and get paid.
- Changing room/Accessibility discussion
 - Meeting the Challenge assessed 6 of our sites for accessibility.
 - Based on the report, we will start to improve accessibility within the park.
- Salida East Update
 - Concrete is getting poured today while the weather is nice.
 - We are on track for a Memorial Day open.
 - The boat ramp is and will remain open.
 - The ability to reserve a site is still closed.
- Public comments on USFS camping
 - Soliciting comments until March 20.

- LCOSI update
 - Currently looking at Hayden Meadows.
 - Parks Recreation and Open Space group to be considered as part of local gov.
 - o Hiring leadership, then backfilling other positions.
 - They are currently focused on the Leadville South area.
 - Goal is to have a management plan before the southern part will open.
 - Ranch buildings are currently owned by CMC

- Looking to transfer property with structures to someone else.
- Consultant working to help figure out how and who to transfer property to.
- Tennessee Pass line by Rio Grande Pacific looking for comments.
 - Still considering line from Eagle to Parkdale (160 miles).
 - Commuter and local freight. (Add comment link)
- May 13th Summer kick-off event
 - AHRA wants to promote safe, fun, responsible recreation.
 - Event will happen at Riverside Park in Salida.
 - We have invited the BLM, USFS, Rec Depts, and Salida Fire.
 - The goal is to target youth and provide information about life jackets and how to properly fit them
 - Cleanup-Greenup (CUGU) and the local Whitewater festivals to promote events.
 - Information or Comment
 - Suggestion: Is it possible to get a sign of just the whitewater park?
 - Add a better map of each feature and where to get out, etc. (For all whitewater parks)
- Private use numbers
 - AHRA is going to look at actual numbers in the Brown's Canyon area and outside.
 - Potential to hire a specific person to gather this data
 - We are also wanting to look at vehicle traffic.
 - Numbers and types of use
- Lowhead Dam
 - We are still hoping that work will begin this fall.
 - We have put out a request for qualifications
 - to request contractors for design work
 - We have applied for grants and other funding.
 - Potential for American Whitewater to fill the gap in funding (talk to Logan)

 - Planning on Fall construction
 - Potential for intermittent closures
 - Signs will be placed at the top of Bald Mtn Gulch Road for offroaders.
