

Cherry Creek State Park Campground



We hope you enjoy your stay with us. We are dedicated to your safety and to the preservation of the natural resources of this State Park. Therefore, we ask that you abide by the following Campground Rules. We thank you in advance for your cooperation.

- Check out time is noon/check in time is 1 p.m. daily. All camping permits must be renewed by noon or vacated. Use self-service only if the Campground Office is closed.
- Camping is limited to 14 days in any 45 day period.
- Observe quiet hours from 10 p.m. to 6 a.m. Generators must be turned off during these hours.
- A maximum of six (6) people, two (2) camping units (only one RV or camper per site), and two (2) vehicles are allowed per site. A “camping unit” is defined as a tent, camper, RV, etc.
- Campsites designated with a “HD” are reserved for handicapped campers only. Handicap placard or plates must be visible.
- All pets must be under control and on a maximum six-foot leash at all times, and not attached to any park signs, trees, shrubs, or hydrants. Pets may not be left unattended.
- Pet owners must promptly clean up after their pets.
- Absolutely nothing may be hung on, from, or attached in any way, to trees, shrubs, or any Park buildings or signs.
- Open-flame fires are permitted only in designated fire pits. Gas and propane grills are allowed.
- The gathering of firewood in the Park is prohibited. Firewood can be purchased at the Campground Office.
- All bathrooms will be closed daily for cleaning purposes. Campers will not be permitted to utilize any bathroom when it is being cleaned.
- Littering, including cigarette butts, is unlawful and harmful to wildlife and the environment.
- Parking at all sites is limited to the length of your site. NO VEHICLES may be parked on either the main roadway or on the grass areas at your site. Additional vehicles/boats/trailers must park in the Camper Service Building parking lot.
- All vehicles must remain entirely on pavement at all times. All trailers must be on blocks when sitting on the asphalt areas of parking pads.
- No motorized scooters or kid cars are allowed in the Campground or any road or trail in the Park.
- The washing of motor vehicles is not allowed in the Campground.
- All vehicles within the park are required to have a valid park pass
