# Reminder: 2019 Draw Changes

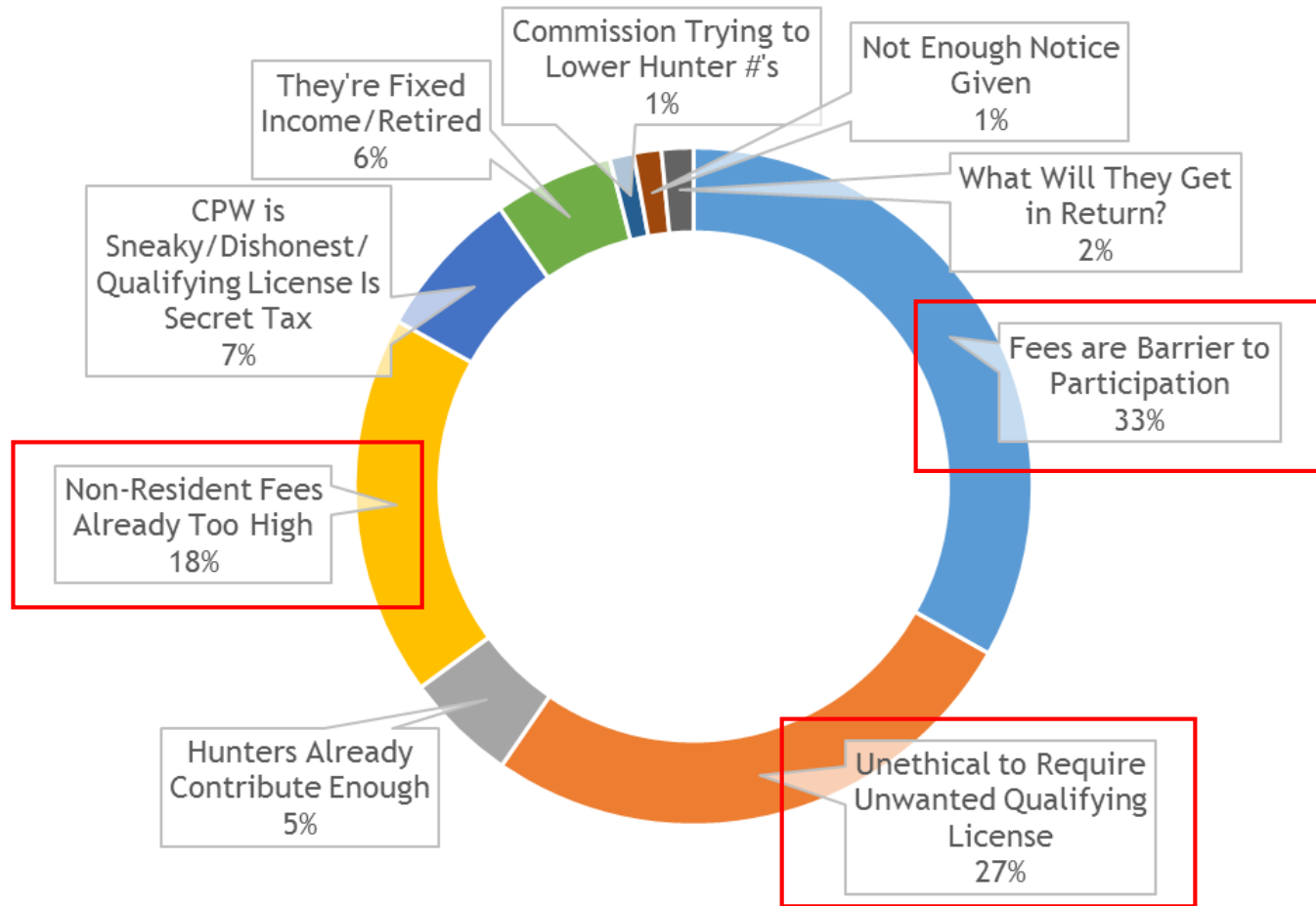
- Require applicants to purchase a qualifying hunting license
- Eliminate preference point fees for deer, elk, pronghorn and bear
- Add preference point fees for Rocky Mountain bighorn sheep, mountain goat and moose
  - \$50 resident/\$100 non-resident

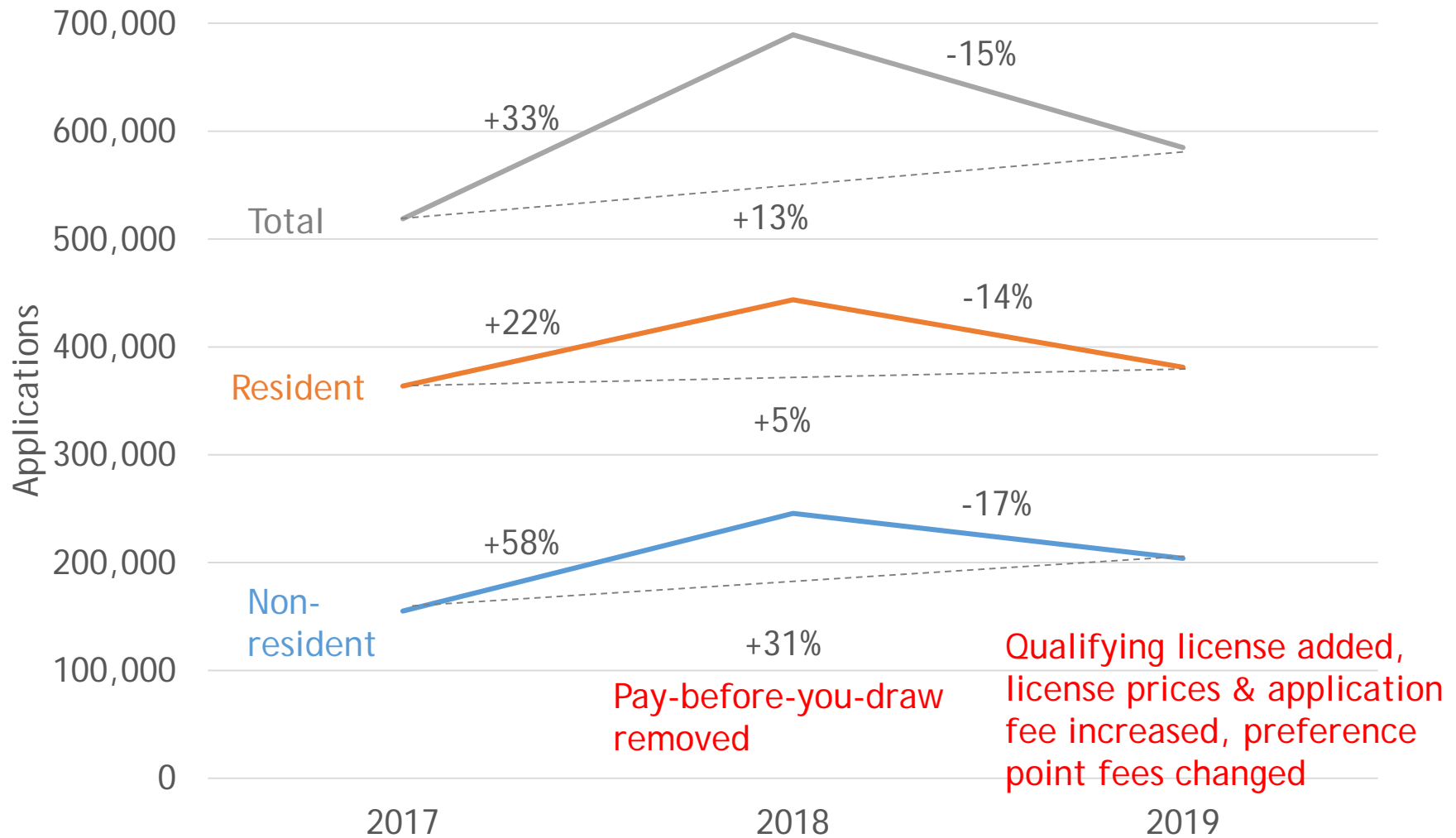

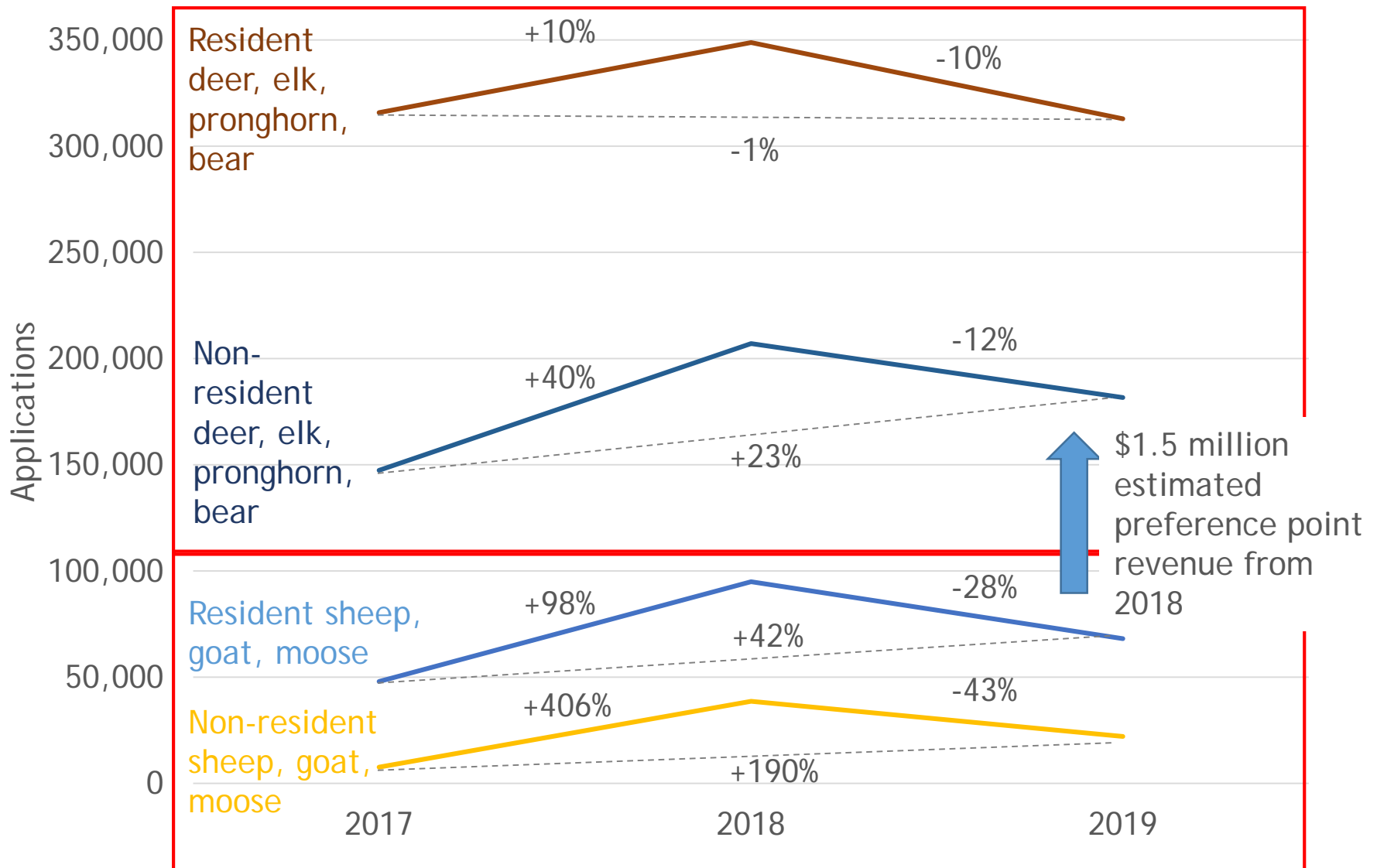

# Change in all application numbers for big game species



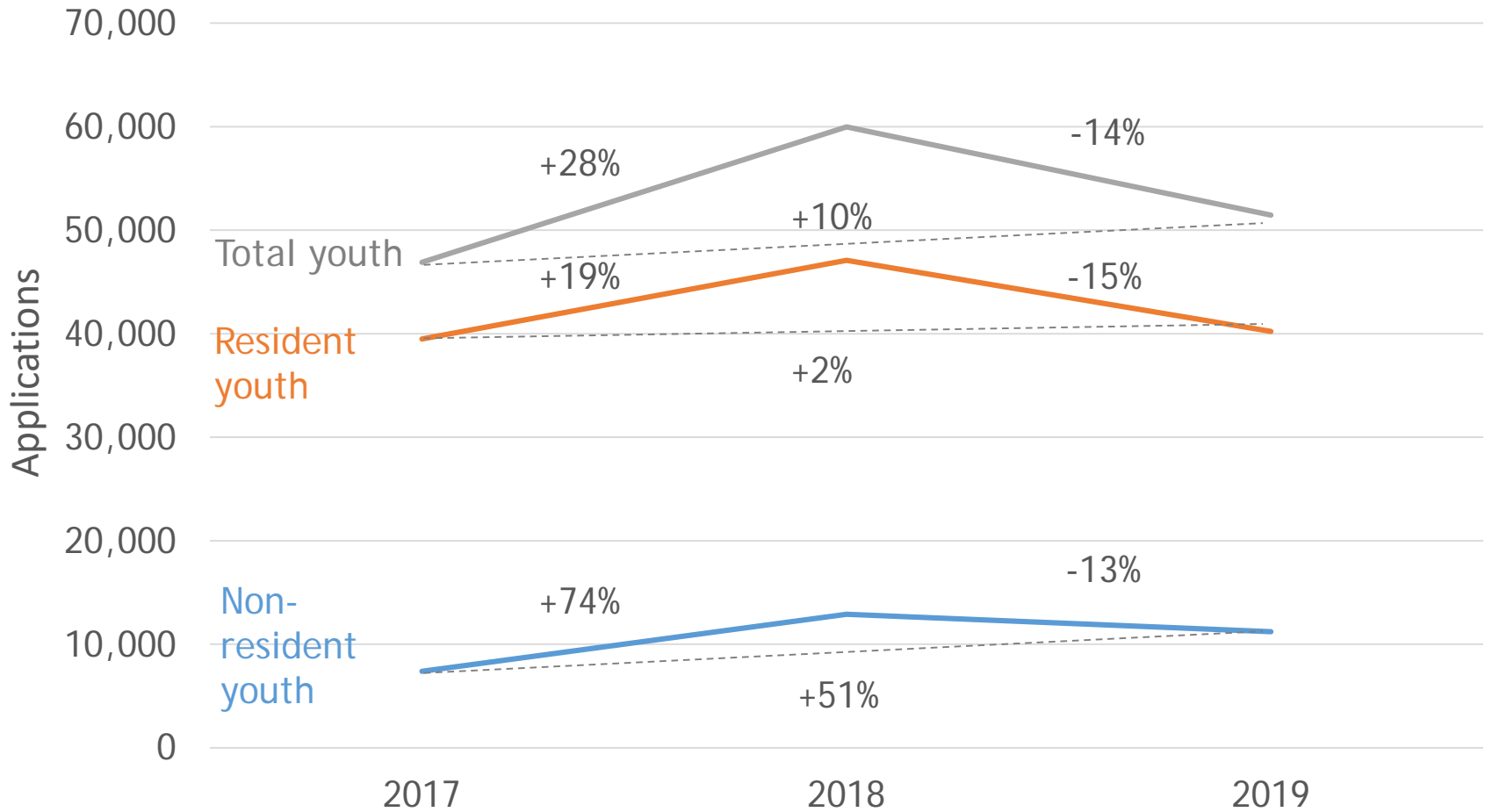

# Change in all application numbers for big game species



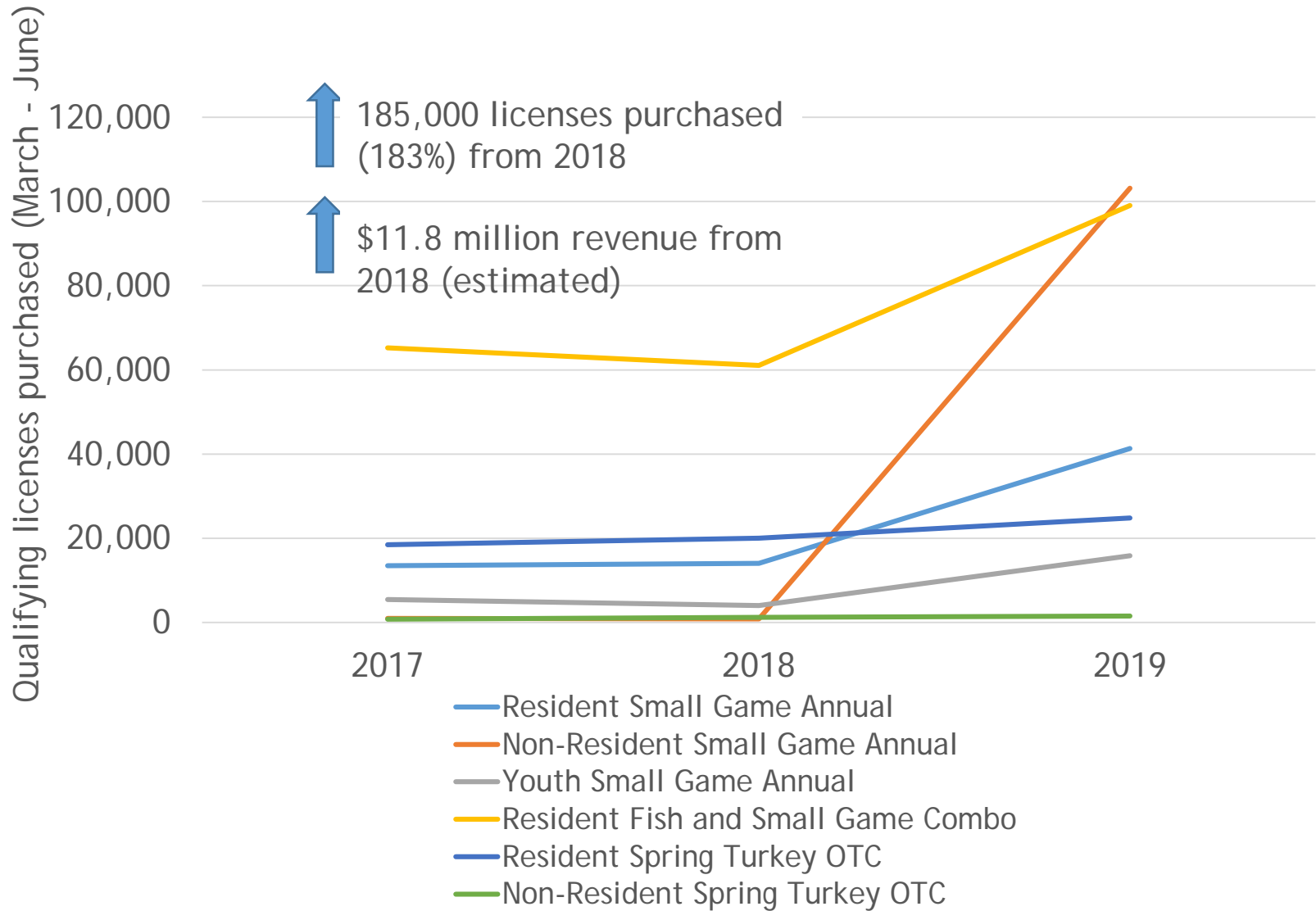

# Summary

	2019 compared to 2018	2019 compared to 2017
All big game applications	 15%	 13%
Residents	 14%	 5%
Non-residents	 17%	 31%
Youth big game applications	 14%	 10%
Residents	 15%	 2%
Non-residents	 13%	 51%

-  \$1.5 million estimated preference point revenue
-  183% qualifying licenses purchased and estimated \$11.8 million in revenue
