

Updated Commission Policy on Public Rulemaking Petitions

1. Division-supported petitions

- Very similar to status quo
- Timing of hearing is discretionary

2. Division-opposed petitions

- Petition not noticed for rulemaking
- Petition placed on consent agenda with written Division rationale for recommended denial
- Any commissioner can remove an item from the consent agenda
 - To seek clarity
 - To schedule it for a specific agenda discussion at a future meeting
- No opportunity for petitioner to present
- Timing of hearing is discretionary

3. Everything else

- Division, Chair consult to discuss future course of proceedings
- Timing of hearing is discretionary
