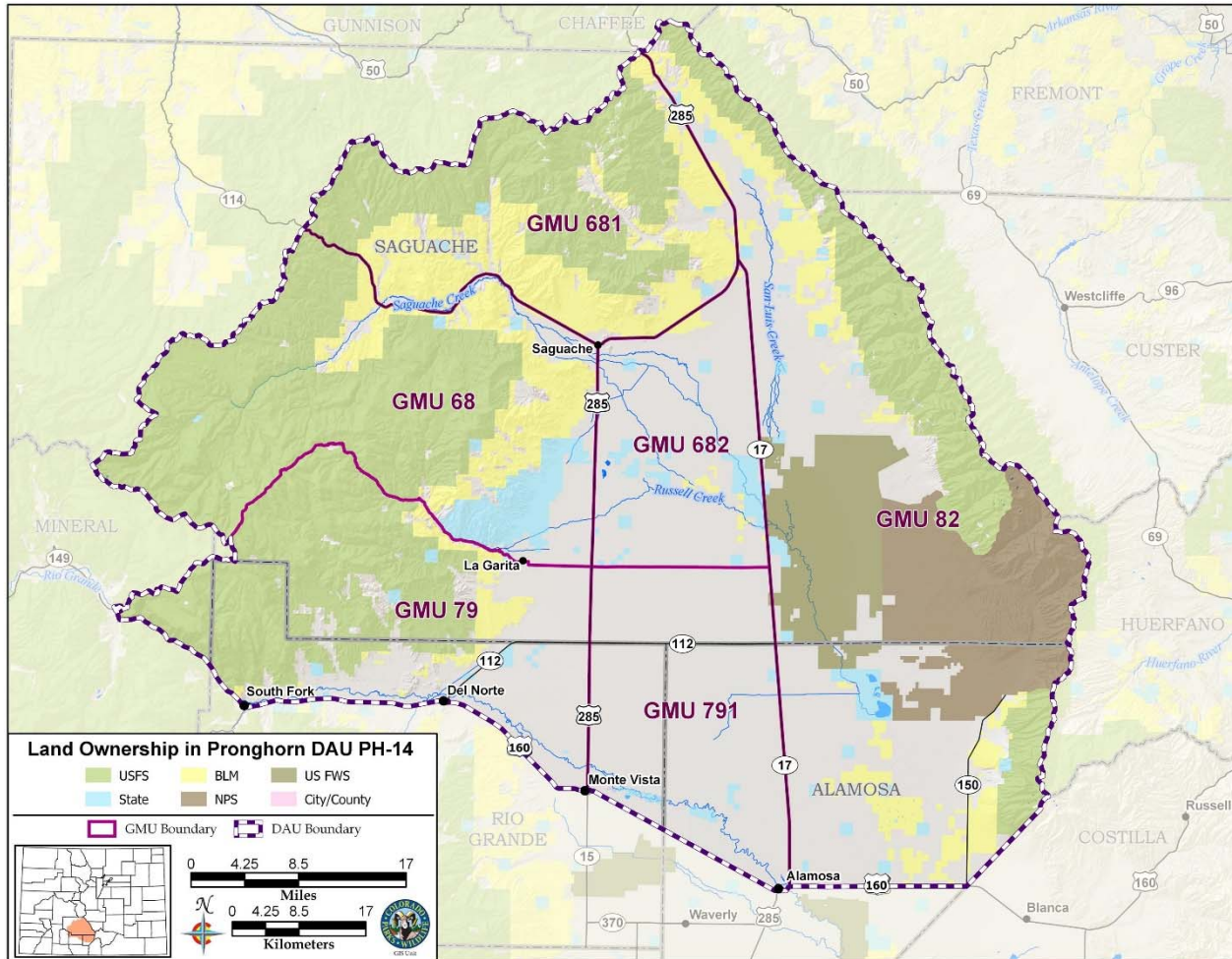

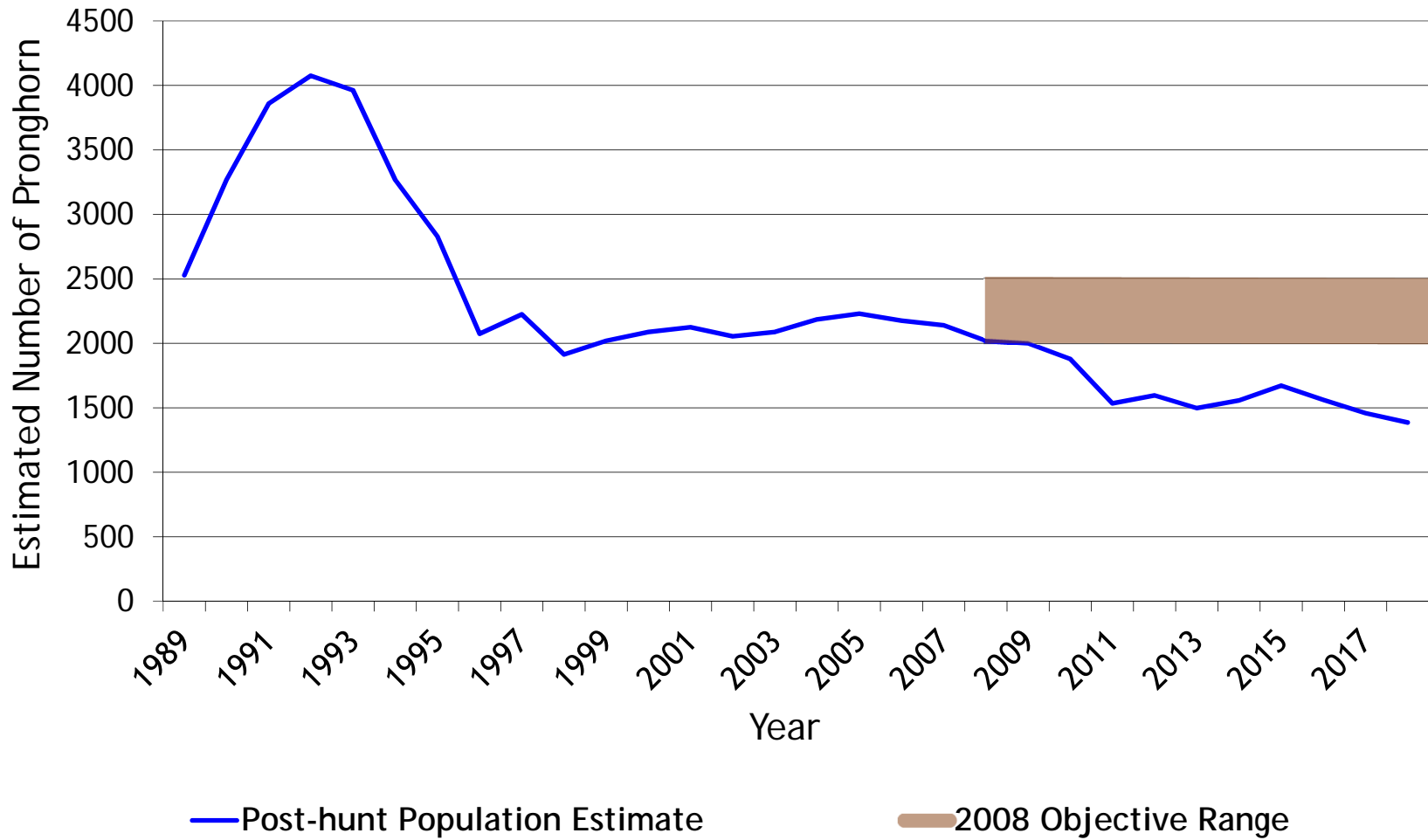
OBJECTIVES SUMMARY

Proposal	Post-hunt Population Size	Pre-hunt Sex Ratio
Current Objective	2,000-2,500 pronghorn	27-33 bucks per 100 does
2018 Model Estimate	1,400 pronghorn	31 bucks per 100 does (Observed 3-year average)
2019 Preferred	2,000-2,500 pronghorn	27-33 bucks per 100 does



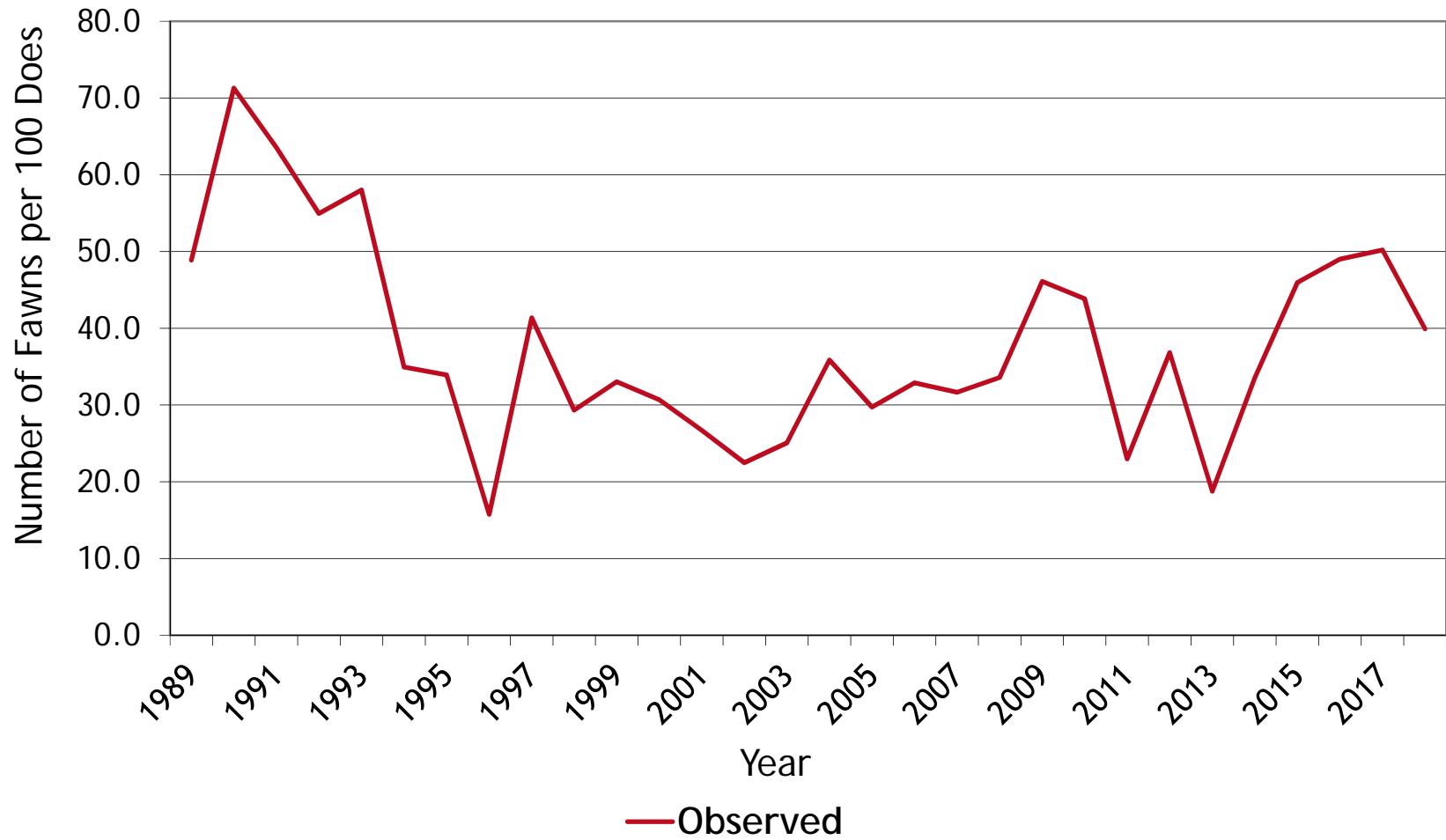
