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Auction and Raffle Licenses

- Authorized by statute (C.R.S. 33-4-116) and PWC Regulation #229
- 18 licenses (9 auction and 9 raffle)





Licenses and Hunters

- Statewide licenses valid in any unit open for that species
- Extended seasons





Revenue

- Total of \$4.4 million generated in the last 5 years
- Total revenue was over \$1 million in 2021
- For big game habitat enhancement, research, management, and education





Auction and Raffle License Contract RFP for 2022-2026 Licenses

- Two-phase Commission authorization
 - Phase 1: June
 - CPW Commission approved RFP
 Evaluation Criteria
 - July RFP release and RFP Evaluation Team review
 - Phase 2: September
 - CPW Commission reviews RFP Team recommendations and authorizes license contracts

- C. Experience and abilities to maximize revenue for the State and wildlife conservation
- D. Use of funds
- E. Licenses requested
