For this financial update there are no new financials to present. The fiscal year ends at the end of this month, but end of year adjustments mean that updated numbers will not be available until the fall. Based on comments made at the last commission meeting, I understand that there is a desire for a deeper understanding of the information reported in the Commission Reports. To further that understanding, attached is the (unreconciled) drill down into the agency's finances. This information provides more detail however I am less able to explain individual numbers without further research.

The Expenditure Summary 2021 file takes the categories in the commission report, which are bolded subheadings, and drills down to the object code name. The Revenue Summary 2021 drills down two levels to the revenue source name and the department revenue source name. For many entries, there is not an additional department revenue source and that will reflect as "not entered." Please note that revenue into the agency is reported as a negative number and expenditures out are reported as positive numbers. You may notice that there is a significant amount of dollars that are marked as "Exclude." These entries have been determined to have a non-cash impact to our financials and are not included in the commission report as the report is intended to be a "sources and uses" of funds report.

The commission report includes some of this detail, primarily the sale of individual product categories, but not all of the detail with the intention of making the report more easily understood. However, I have presented this information today to give more context to the numbers that I regularly present. There are further layers of information that fill out the story of these numbers but the presentation gets increasing more complex as we drill further into that detail.
