CPW Proposed New Structure

Concession Agreements -

- longer than 1 year
- require investments in infrastructure

Activity Permits -

- up to one year in length
- may require special planning/scheduling for proper management
- requires an application, application fee, and liability insurance, as needed worker comp insurance, vehicle insurance, First Aid/CPR certs, and additional certifications as appropriate

Event Permits -

- one time daily or consecutive days for specific date(s)
- may require special planning/scheduling for proper management
- requires an application, application fee, and liability insurance.





New Regulations and Fee Structure

- All regulations in one place in Chapter W-16
- New fees set in regulation
- Standardized forms for the agency
- Updated administrative directives

- Parks Administrative
 Directives 1995
- Wildlife Administrative
 Directives 2007
- Parks and Wildlife merged in 2011
