Policy No. C-176

SUBJECT: DONATION OF MATERIAL OBJECTS

I. PURPOSE

The Board of Parks and Outdoor Recreation recognized the educational and interpretive benefits derived from the collection of objects of natural, cultural and historical significance and hereby authorizes the Division of Parks and Outdoor Recreation to accept the donation of such objects consistent with the following guidelines.


II. ACCEPTABILITY PROVISIONS

The Division of Parks and Outdoor Recreation is authorized to accept the donation objects which specifically relate to the Division's goals for the interpretation of the natural, cultural and historical values of Colorado.

- A. Approval for the donation's acceptance must be given by the Board of Parks and Outdoor Recreation based on recommendations made by the Division Director, (see Policy No. C-175).
- B. Criteria used to evaluate the acceptability of a material donation include the following considerations:
 1. Compatability with the Division's interpretive goals and programs.
 2. The Division's ability to provide proper storage, security, and maintenance.
 3. Project plans for use of the object(s).
- C. Donated objects will become the absolute property of the State of Colorado, Division of Parks and Outdoor Recreation and will be received without limiting conditions and to be used at the discretion of the Division.
