ON-LINE TOURNAMENT WAS HELD JANUARY 16<sup>TH</sup> - FEBRUARY 9<sup>TH</sup>

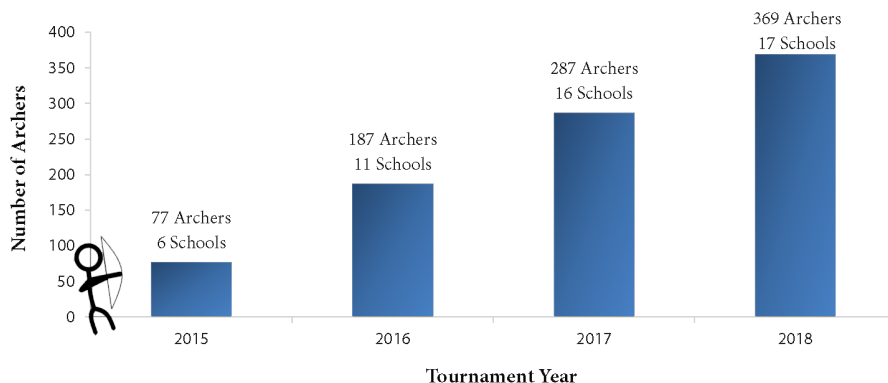
In early 2018, Colorado Parks and Wildlife hosted our 4<sup>th</sup> Annual NASP® State Tournament.



This *virtual* tournament gives every Colorado student who participates in the National Archery in the Schools Program (NASP®) the chance to compete with archers across the state right in their home gym.

Students who qualify during the Colorado state tournament are invited to participate in the NASP® Western Nationals Tournament in Sandy, Utah on April 13<sup>th</sup> and 14<sup>th</sup>. First place teams in each division (elementary, middle, and high school) as well as the top 10 male and top 10 female individual archers from each division qualify for Nationals.
