**Colorado Parks and Wildlife invites all schools participating in NASP to the Colorado State Tournament.**

This *virtual* tournament gives every student that participates in the NASP® during the school day the chance to compete with other archers around the state and the opportunity to qualify for the National Tournament in Louisville, Kentucky.

- The Virtual Tournament will be open to all Colorado Schools that currently have a certified Basic Archery Instructor (BAI) and participate in NASP.
- Registration on [www.nasptournaments.org](http://www.nasptournaments.org) will begin on **January 7, 2019** and will end on **February 8<sup>th</sup>**. Teachers will need their BAI# to gain access to the registration site.
- Schools participate in the tournament by holding a formal competition on their school grounds during the dates that the State Tournament is open (January 14<sup>th</sup>-February 8<sup>th</sup>).
- See the **Official National Archery Tournament Rules** for tournament details.
- The registration fee of **\$2.50 per scored student** is payable on-line during registration on the NASP website.
- The State Virtual Tournament can be held at your school or in cooperation with other schools.
- Schools may participate as a team or as individuals and there is no limit on the number that may participate.
- NASP tournament teams must be comprised of students separated by grade divisions as follows: Elementary (4-5), Middle (6-8), & High School (9-12). Schools may enter more than one team per division.
- Tournament scores are entered into the NASP Tournament database by the teacher or coach and the results are tallied electronically. Teachers can view the statewide rankings of all the participating Colorado Schools.
- While all of the team members shoot on tournament day, only the top 12 shooters (of which 4 being the opposite gender), will be used to determine the overall team score.
- **Scores will be finalized and posted by February 10, 2019.**
- Top scoring teams and individuals will be eligible to compete in the WESTERN National Tournament in Salt Lake City, Utah near Salt Lake City in April 26-27, 2019.
- Top scoring teams will receive trophies and the top scoring male and female individuals in each division will receive state champion Genesis bows.
