

CREATE A GRASSAPILLAR



Tired of getting in trouble for having real bugs into the house? Create your very own, indoor friendly, caterpillar with just a few simple household objects. Celebrate the arrival of spring by bringing this fuzzy critter to life and watch as it grows and grows! This craft is courtesy of Disney Family Fun Crafts.

Materials:

- Egg Carton
- Grass Seed
- Potting Soil
- Water



Instructions:

1. Begin by mixing 3/4 cup of potting soil and 2 tablespoons of grass seed in a bowl.
2. Add water to moisten the mixture, and then set it aside.
3. Cut away a three-cup section of an egg carton, and then trim the section along the longer edges so that your grassapillar will look the same from both sides.
4. With a permanent marker, draw a face on one end as shown.
5. Gently spoon the seed mixture into the cups.
6. Wait. Set your creation on a dish in a brightly lit spot and keep the soil moist. The grass should sprout in about a week.
