



CREATE YOUR OWN ICE SUN CATCHER

Kids can add a splash of color to their backyards this winter with a homemade ice sun catcher. As long as the weather is cold, this craft will remain frozen and intact. This craft is courtesy of Disney's Family Fun Crafts.

Allow your child two to three hours to create this outdoor decoration.

Materials

- An ice cube tray
- Food coloring
- Ribbon
- Plastic cup
- Round cake pan

Instructions

1. Begin by adding one to three drops of food coloring to the water in each section of the tray. These colorful ice cubes will run together in the pan later, so use only a few matching colors.
2. Freeze the cubes completely. Next, fill a round cake pan about two-thirds full of water.
3. To make the hole for the ribbon, set a plastic cup full of water in the pan. Place the pan in the freezer for an hour or so.
4. Put the colored ice cubes in the pan, and then allow all the liquid to freeze solid.
5. Remove the plastic cup, flip the sun catcher out of the pan, then hang it outside with a holiday ribbon.
