



MAKE YOUR OWN BIRD BATH

Watching birds in your backyard is a great way to learn more about the natural world in which we live. There are thousands of different types of birds flying around us, wouldn't it be fun if some of them stopped by your house?

This easy-to-make bird bath is a great way to invite some beautiful birds over to your own backyard. Grab an adult and work together to make this bird-friendly craft. Keep it filled with water so they can come by and have a drink or cool off!



Materials

- Roll of natural rope or twine
- 15-inch grapevine or other type of wreath (can be found at local craft store)
- 10-inch terra cotta saucer (available at craft or garden store)
- Artificial leaves or flower to decorate
- Cool water

Instructions

1. Cut three 5-foot lengths of rope or twine and knot the length together at each end.
2. Rest of the wreath inside the rope.
3. Place the terra cotta saucer inside the wreath
4. Hang the bird feeder in your yard or by a window for easy viewing.
5. Fill the saucer with clean, cool water.
6. Watch the birds flock to your backyard!
