

## Nomination Instructions

Nominations must include:

1. A completed 2020 Limited Elk Unit Nomination Form.
2. Documentation of public support for limiting or de-limiting an elk unit or Data Analysis Unit (DAU). This can include signature petitions (including addresses of the signatories), letters of support from individuals or interest groups, or any other relevant information.
3. Documentation that the interest groups listed below, at a minimum, have been formally notified of the nomination and have been provided with a copy of the nomination form.
  - Local government officials including the Boards of County Commissioners and City/Town Councils geographically associated with the DAU
  - Colorado Wool Growers and the Colorado Cattleman's Association
  - Local Chambers of Commerce
  - Hunter organizations
  - Colorado Outfitters Association
  - Local Habitat Partnership Program committees
4. A proposed DAU management objective. In most cases, this management objective should be provided as a desired range of posthunt bull/cow ratios specified as being either observed or modeled. Other management objectives may be considered but they must be clearly defined.

Nominations will be evaluated based on the amount of public support for the change in management and the potential of the proposed DAU to support the proposed management objective. Certain DAUs may be proposed by the public that due to animal movements (e.g., movement between surrounding DAUs or across state lines), refuge areas, and other mitigating biological factors do not lend themselves to management for the proposed objective
