Ranch Rules

1. Please be aware of the image you project while hunting on the Bord Gulch Ranch, as we adhere to all game and firearm laws that apply to your hunt. All violations will be handled according to the letter of the law. All violations will result in the forfeiture of your hunt.
2. Bord Gulch Ranch Check-In location is at the barn, located on the west side of Moffat County Road 17, 1 mile south of the junction of Moffat County Roads 7 and 17 (approximately 17 miles northwest of Craig, CO). A phone number will be provided at Check-In to call for Check-Out and to report hunt success.
3. Check-In Procedure (REQUIRED PRIOR TO HUNTING):
 - For **ALL Deer, Pronghorn, and Either-Sex Elk License Holders-**
 - Check-In will be held from 4:00 PM - 6:00 PM in the afternoon/evening on the day immediately prior to the start of your season.
 - **IF YOU ARE UNABLE TO ATTEND THE REQUIRED CHECK-IN DATE AND TIME, NOTICE IS REQUIRED AND MUST BE MADE BY CONTACTING RAY OWENS AT LEAST 48 HOURS PRIOR TO YOUR CHECK-IN DATE TO MAKE ALTERNATIVE ARRANGEMENTS. FAILING TO CHECK-IN PRIOR TO HUNTING WILL RESULT IN THE FORFEITURE OF YOUR HUNT.**
 - For **ALL Antlerless Elk License Holders-**
 - For those who plan to hunt opening day/weekend, Check-In will be held from 4:00 PM - 6:00 PM in the afternoon on the day immediately prior to the start of your season. License holders who plan to attend this Check-In Date/Time may just show up and do not need to contact Ray Owens.
 - For those who plan to hunt later in the season (not opening day/weekend), you may contact Ray Owens no later than two weeks prior to the start of the season to schedule an alternative Check-In Date/Time to be held prior to your planned hunt date(s).
 - **IF YOU ARE UNABLE TO ATTEND YOUR CHECK-IN DATE AND TIME, NOTICE IS REQUIRED AND MUST BE MADE BY CONTACTING RAY OWENS AT LEAST 48 HOURS PRIOR TO YOUR CHECK-IN DATE TO MAKE ALTERNATIVE ARRANGEMENTS. FAILING TO CHECK-IN PRIOR TO HUNTING WILL RESULT IN THE FORFEITURE OF YOUR HUNT.**
4. No OHV use is allowed on the ranch. Vehicle traffic is allowed on existing roads only.

5. Public hunters are allowed the full use of the ranch except around livestock facilities. Depending on livestock concentrations there could be temporary closures of pastures.
6. There will be no access allowed for scouting. Maps will be provided as general references and are not considered a source of navigation. Trespassing will not be tolerated.
7. Possible wounded animals that cannot be recovered will not count as animals harvested. Please advise agents of the Ranch if it happens.
8. One rifle per license is allowed on ranch. No party hunting allowed.
9. Only one non-hunter will be allowed to accompany each licensed hunter and they must be in the same vehicle.
10. No camping is allowed on the ranch.
11. No fires are allowed on the ranch.
12. Please pack out your trash. No littering; including but not limited to trash, hides, and bones.
13. All rifles must be sighted prior to entering the ranch. NO causal shooting is permitted.
14. All hunters and guests will be required to sign a release of liability form at time of Check-In. This will also serve as your permit to be on the property. This document must be produced when requested by an officer or ranch agent.
15. Please respect our ranch, roads, and livestock. Maximum speed is 20 MPH.
16. No consumption of alcohol or drugs is permitted on the ranch.
17. Please leave all gates and fences as you find them.
18. **The above rules plus any additional information deemed appropriate by the ranch and CPW will be sent to all successful hunters. Any violations of rules, CPW regulations, or state statutes will mean revocation of hunting privileges on Bord Gulch Ranch.**
