

# **Rimrock Wildlife Management Area**

Welcome to the Rimrock Wildlife Management Area. We hope that you have a quality hunting experience and are successful with your hunt while using our private lands. The following rules are in effect for this area, please observe them.

1. You must check in at the designated check in point prior to the hunt and check out when your hunt has been completed, successful or not.
2. Look before you shoot. Our cattle and horses are grazing these lands and are the same color as game animals.
3. Please stay on established roads and trails.
4. No open fires, no littering no alcohol and no dogs on ranch property.
5. No camping on Ranch property. A campground is available in Kim and they have hook ups and showers. The phone number is 719-468-9185 . The nearest hotels are in La Junta, Springfield or Trinidad. These towns are 60-70 miles away.
6. No gutting of animals in or near water supplies, including windmills and ponds. You may gather water from these sources for cleaning purposes.
7. Only one additional person may accompany the licensed hunter while hunting.
8. Coyotes may be hunted provided the hunter has the required state license.
9. Obey all State statutes.
10. Gates shall be left as you find them. When in doubt, please close them.
11. ATV's are not allowed on ranch property.
12. Please return the maps to the check in point at the end of your hunt.

**ANY VIOLATION OF THESE RULES WILL RESULT IN EXPULSION FROM THE RIMROCK WILDLIFE MANAGEMENT AREA.**

The Kim Outpost, located in Kim, is open M-F from 7:30 a.m. to 5 p.m. Unleaded gasoline may be purchased at the store. They have a grill serving breakfast and lunch and carry basic grocery and staple supplies. The Kim Outpost does not have diesel and is not open on weekends. Please note that La Junta, Trinidad or Springfield is the last source for fuel before getting to Kim.
