**Typical Projects Funded:** Water Developments, Fencing, Habitat Improvements, Conservation Easements, Prescribed burns, Noxious Weed Treatments

**Typical Project Match Desired:** Varies depending on project type and scope

**Applicant Required to Attend Meetings:** Yes

**Prior CPW Project Involvement/Review Needed:** Yes, DWM must support project

**Special information on Conservation Easements:** The ARHPP committee requests that any applicant proposing a conservation easement comes prepared with the following information:

- What kind of hunting and fishing parameters are included in the easement?
- What are the plans or parameters concerning forest/habitat health and wildfire mitigation?
- What are the parameters for grazing or agricultural use?
- Information on water rights for the property.
