Committee Name: Lower Colorado River

Meeting Schedule: Meetings are usually held 4-5 times a year, but more meetings may be held if necessary. Also, a summer project tour is usually scheduled.

Meeting Times: Typically 1:00 - 3:00PM

Meeting Location: Alternates between the Glenwood Springs CPW office and Eagle area, check with local DWM.

Project Applications Needed: Yes. Current applications must be used and they can be found at: <http://cpw.state.co.us/hpp>

Agricultural Status Required for Projects: No, but agricultural status is preferred and considered during review of the project.

Hunting Access Required: Highly encouraged.

Typical Projects Funded: Fencing, weed spraying, habitat enhancement. Applications need to clearly state how the project will resolve current/potential conflicts between big game (deer, elk, pronghorn, moose) and agricultural operators or help CPW to meet game management objectives (deer, elk, pronghorn, moose).

Typical Project Match Desired: 50/50 match is highly preferred.

Applicant Required to Attend Meetings: It is preferred that the applicant attend the meeting to answer any questions the committee members may have. If the applicant is not able to attend, they need to have someone there on their behalf that can speak to the project and answer questions for the committee. The committee reserves the right to not approve the project if there are unanswered questions regarding the project.

Prior CPW Project Involvement/Review Needed: Applicant is required to meet with their local District Wildlife Manager prior to committee meeting to review project.
