Typical Projects Funded: Stackyards, wildlife friendly fencing, water developments, habitat manipulation, fence/weed vouchers.

Typical Project Match Desired: 50%

Applicant Required to Attend Meetings: No. However, landowner involvement is encouraged. If the landowner is unable to attend, then the local DWM should be asked to present the project proposal on the landowner's behalf.

Prior CPW Project Involvement/Review Needed: Yes. Project applications will not be reviewed by the committee until the local District Wildlife Manager has had an opportunity to review the project details and/or project application.
