Introductions & Budget Report:

Committee members were introduced. The remaining budget at the start of the meeting was \$72,190.00.

New Business:

1. Fertilizer applications were approved as follows: James Oliver, \$2,550.00 (170 acres). Eddie Oliver, \$1,320.00 (88 acres).
2. The committee reviewed a fencing application from Gayel Alexander. Previous fencing projects have been completed and there are two ¼-mile sections remaining. The existing fence is old barbed wire, with woven wire along the bottom. The fence is in disrepair and does not keep cattle in, and prevents big game movement across the area. The project involves removing the old fencing, clearing the fence line, and constructing new wildlife-friendly fencing. The committee approved \$2,748.18 for materials and labor.

Other Business:

1. Ivan Messinger informed the committee that the USFS was developing an application for a vegetation project, and hopes to present that proposal in the spring.
