Budget Report

The 2019 budget report was reviewed.

Old Business

Hanna has been in touch with Midwest Tire Tanks and has requested that they fill out the load for the order that is being placed for the Sangre de Cristo committee. The full load will be approximately 14 10ft tires tanks for \$8,400. The SDC committee has already committed \$5,000 for 8 tanks, so the AR committee will cover the remaining cost and take the remaining tanks. They are still trying to figure out if the tanks can be shipped to two different places, but Hanna will update everyone once that is worked out. The SDC committee still needs 8ft tanks. The AR committee agreed that now that they don't need to directly trade tanks with the SDC committee, they are willing to donate some of their 8ft tanks to them so that both committees have a good number of 8ft and 10ft tanks. A purchase order will need to be approved before the order is made, so Hanna is currently working with the vendor to get that done.

New Business

Project Application Proposals and Reviews

Sportsperson Representative

At the last meeting, the committee narrowed the sportsman's representative candidates down to two finalists-Conrad Dreher and Ty Woodward. The committee feels that both candidates are well qualified, but some feel that Ty's current working experience with private landowners and fellow sportsman would be a great asset to the committee in helping to find and create

new and enhanced hunting opportunities in the area. Each committee member voted, and Ty won the majority vote. The committee thanks Conrad for his effort and dedication.

Ty will need to be appointed by the Wildlife Commission before he gets voting power, so Hanna will send Ty's information over to add his name to an upcoming commission agenda.

Remaining Committee Business/Other Discussion

There has been some interest in installing signs near HPP projects indicating that they were funded by HPP/other cooperators. The committee is interested in doing this, and will start looking into options.
