#### **Old Business:**

1. Voucher program rules were reviewed. The following was approved:

#### **Fence:**

- Minimum 80 acres, leased acres qualify
- \$200 increments
- Up to 3 vouchers per landowner annually, if DWM determines need is greater than \$200.
  - If need is greater than \$600, landowners should apply for a fencing project
  - DWMs give out applications for fence voucher; landowner submits application to admin. Voucher must be obtained prior to purchasing materials.
- 1 roll of white wire per voucher may be distributed if landowner requests it on the application.

#### **Herbicide:**

- \$200 increments
- Up to 2 vouchers per landowner annually, if DWM determines need is greater than \$200.
- DWMs distribute approved vouchers directly to landowners
- No minimum number of acres required

#### **Fertilizer:**

- 25% of annual budget
- Landowners may apply for the number of irrigated, forage-producing acres. Dryland or row crops do not qualify.
- No minimum number of acres required, leased acres qualify
