<u>Introductions</u>

Budget Report

The budget balance at the start of the meeting was \$0.00.

New Business

Nichols Fence- Travis Bybee presented a fence voucher application on behalf of Ben Nichols. The current fence is old and in disrepair. Deer and Elk use the properties seasonally and are hard on the fence. The scope of the project includes replacing ½ mile of fencing using wildlife-friendly specs. The project was approved for \$6,064.00. *Administrative Note- \$6,064.00 of project funding approved by HPP Manager.

<u>Wheeler Fence-</u> Duke Wheeler presented a fence project to the committee. The current fence is old and in need of repair. Deer and elk use the property seasonally and are hard on the fence. The project's scope is to replace ½ mile of fencing using wildlife-friendly specs. The project was approved for \$1,787.19.

*Administrative Note- \$1,787.19 of project funding approved by HPP Manager.

<u>Mamm Creek Seeding Phase 2-</u> Duke Wheeler presented phase 2 of a seeding project that the committee had approved in FY23. The project site sits in important big game habitat and experiences year-round use by elk and deer. The first half of the project

The District Wildlife Managers in the area have been having more requests for fence vouchers for operations that are smaller than what the minimum acreage is right now (80 acres). The committee decided to add a clause to the guideline that DWMs may use their discretion when issuing fence vouchers.

Goat Grazing- The committee had a discussion about goat grazing and its uses.
