FEBRUARY 2020 EDITION - LICENSE & PASS ADMINISTRATION

13 MONTH LICENSE YEAR - Beginning March 2020

Annual hunting and fishing licenses (such as fishing, small game, furbearer, and combo small game/fishing) are now valid from March 1-March 31 of the following year (13 months) instead of April 1-March 31.

2020 annual licenses will go on sale March 1, 2020 and be valid through March 31, 2021. 2019 annual license sales will end February 29, 2020, but are valid through March 31, 2020. This eliminates the dual license year, so only one license year of annual licenses will be on sale at a time.

2020 Habitat Stamps went on sale with Spring Turkey applications in January and are valid for all 2020 licenses through March 31, 2021.

Product X02 Resident Senior Combo license (small game and fishing) will be available for purchase to residents 65 years of age or older on March 31, 2020, for \$29.75 (includes Search & Rescue and Wildlife Educations fees).

2020 BIG GAME BROCHURES



2019 HUNTING VOUCHERS

Now that all seasons have concluded, please make sure you have sent in all hunting vouchers (Landowner Preference Program and Ranching for Wildlife vouchers) in your green pre-paid envelopes. These vouchers must be returned by March 20, 2020.

NON-RESIDENT SNOWMOBILE PERMIT

Non-resident customers can purchase non-resident snowmobile permits with all agents. They have to be a non-resident and the product can be found under the Park Passes button (refer to the picture below). Colorado residents are required to register their snowmobiles.

AFFIDAVITS AND RECEIPTS

REMINDER: Please DO NOT send in your receipts or affidavits that are signed by your customers. You are to retain these documents for your records. Your agency is required to keep all affidavits & receipt tape for 2 years (current year plus the previous). Receipt tape and affidavits must be kept in a secure place away from the view of the public and the possibility of them being lost or thrown away. Please destroy old documentation that you are not required to keep at your agency as the documents have sensitive customer information.
