Request for Duplicate License Mail-In Instructions

Applicant shall complete one form for each license they wish to replace. Sign and mail completed form to **Colorado Parks & Wildlife, Northeast Region Office, 6060 Broadway, Denver, CO 80216**, together with a check or money order in appropriate amount as stated below:

- Annual Fishing, Small Game, Furbearer, Combination Small Game and Fishing Licenses – the replacement fee is \$5.00.
- Extra Rod Stamp – the replacement fee is \$4.50.
- Colorado Waterfowl Stamps – the replacement fee is \$5.07.
**Federal Waterfowl Stamps and OHV Permits cannot be replaced at a discounted rate – you must purchase a new one, if lost/destroyed.
- Senior Annual Fishing and Senior Low-Income Lifetime Licenses – the replacement fee is \$5.00.
- All other Licenses/Stamps/Permits, including Big Game and Turkey Licenses – the replacement fee is 50% of the cost of the original license to be replaced, but not to exceed \$25.00 per license.

A CPW Official will issue a duplicate license if satisfied as to the facts of the case.
