# Colorado Parks and Wildlife Snowmobile Program

- Program was established in 1977
- Partners with Colorado Snowmobile Association – 35 clubs
  - Grooming, Signing, Own and Maintain Equipment
- CPW staff
  - Administer Grants
  - Process Grooming Payments
  - Registration Program
  - Accident Reporting
  - Education- Back Country Skills, Avalanche Awareness, Safety Class
  - Snowmobile Patrols

# CPW Snowmobile Program Funding

## Federal Funding - RTP

Gas tax funding returned for off road use

40% Diversified projects (\$127,500)

30% Non Motorized projects

30% Motorized ( $\frac{1}{2}$  to OHV and  $\frac{1}{2}$  to snow)



## State Funding

Approx. 32,000 registrations sold @ \$30.25



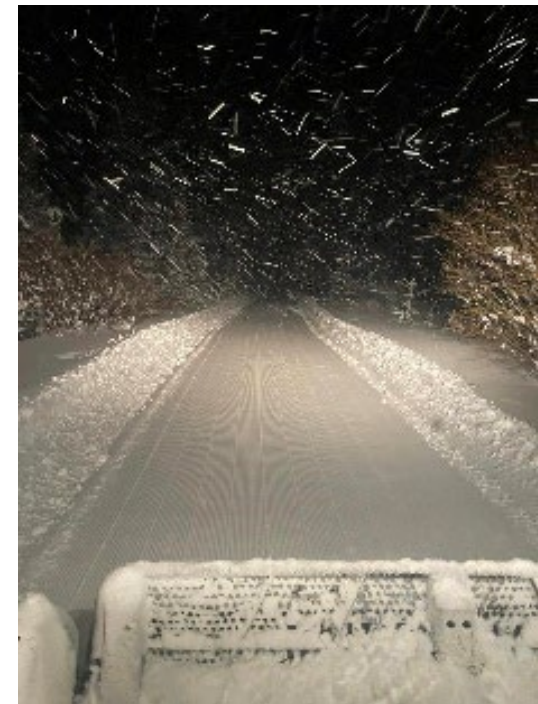
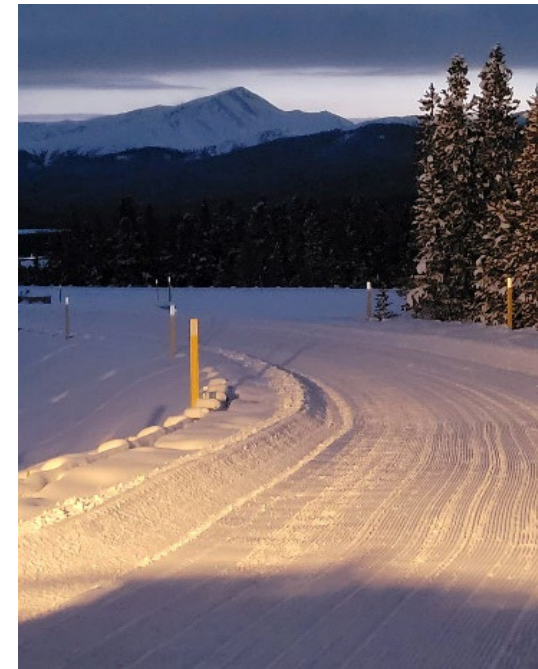

# Winter Trail Grooming Program

- 27 snowmobile clubs
- Funded through snowmobile registration and RTP funds
- 3,300 miles of grooming occurs under USFS Special Use Permits
- Grooming allocations based on formula: miles of trails and amount of use
- Groomed trails are open to all users including non-motorized users



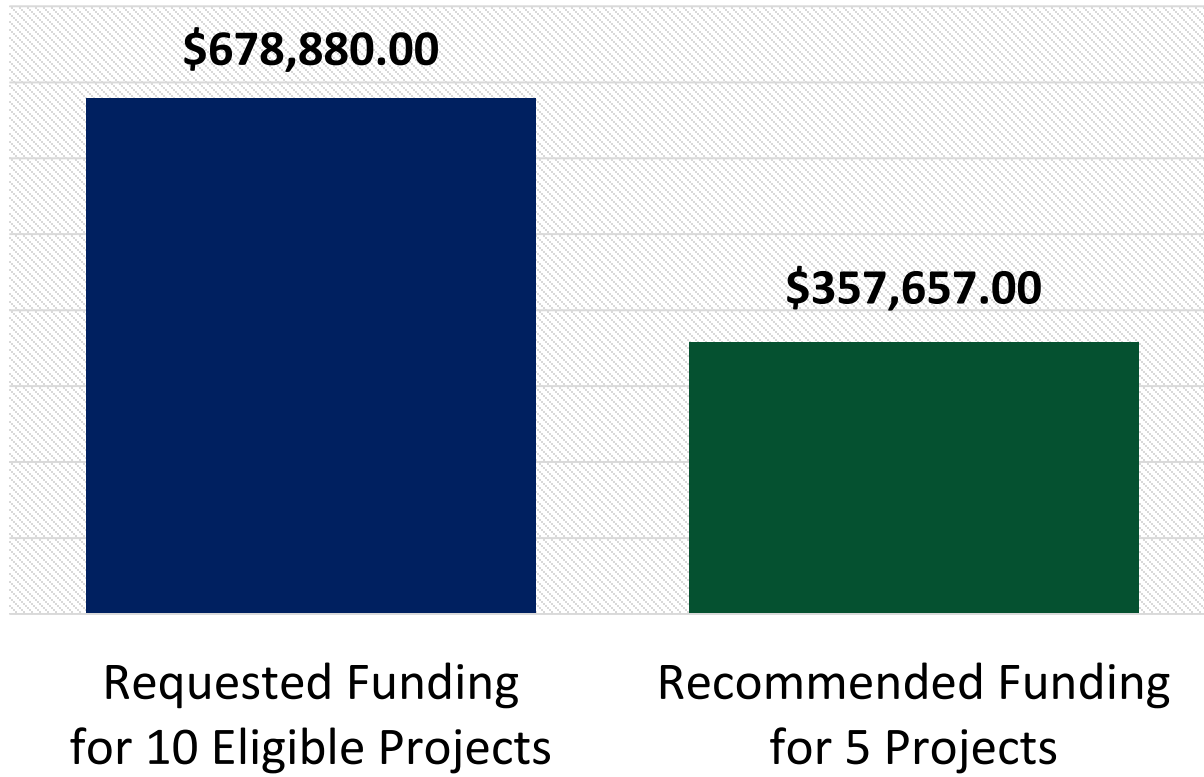

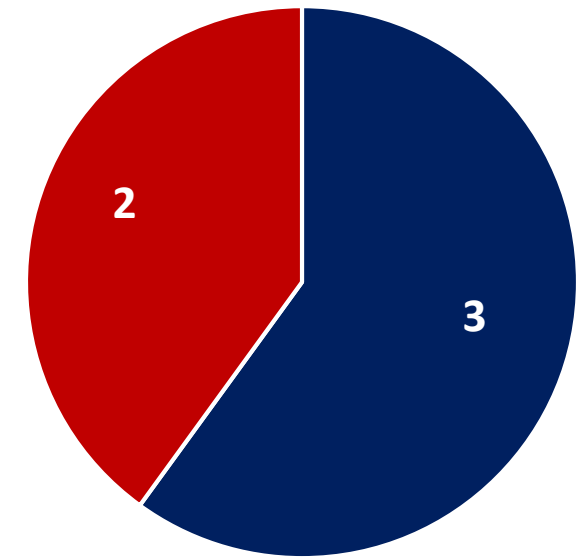
- Funded with snowmobile registration funds and federal RTP funds
