In accordance with state statute, the Committee reviews, scores, and ranks grant applications and formulates grant funding recommendations for the Colorado Parks and Wildlife (CPW) Trail Program.

The Committee also advises the Commission on all matters pertaining to trails, their use, extent, location and funding. State Trail Committee members are expected to represent the perspective of both their own trail use interests as well as the broader community of trail and outdoor recreation users in Colorado.
