We can preform much better maintenance and inspections on the cat with a little heat.

With out the tiller we do more damage to the trails than just leaving them ungroomed.

The tiller hasn't had a summer maintenance performed by the Prinoth dealer. We know we need a complete change of all gearbox oils, check the hydraulic and the drive system. It is time sensitive as we have to set up an appointment as quickly as possible to get it in.
