### **JOB DESCRIPTION:**

The Angler Education Assistant will help with various aspects of fishing clinics along the Front Range of Colorado. The majority of the work will be in the Denver-Metro area. Other duties will include assembling fishing rods, organizing equipment, repairing equipment, teaching fishing clinics and scheduling fishing clinics, working with volunteers and other organizations, and other duties as assigned. Scheduling groups for fishing clinics at a private lake CPW manages. The applicant needs to be willing to work some weekends and evenings depending on when fishing clinics are scheduled. The applicant will be expected to work 40 hours per week. Highly desirable applicants will have experience with teaching/education. The applicant may be asked to help other staff in the Education Section or Northeast Region at CPW. The selected applicant will be required to have an annual fishing license.

### **MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:**

Applicant needs to meet the following requirements:

- Be at least 18 years old.
- Have their own transportation and a valid driver's license.
- Have experience teaching.
- Be flexible with work hours.
- Able to routinely lift 50 pounds and occasionally 75 pounds.
- Have good communication and computer skills such as writing, word processing, and excel.
