- Mowing and trimming operations throughout the park.
- Operation of tractors and mowing equipment.
- Operation of forestry equipment.

- Operation of herbicide application equipment.

- General park maintenance and cleaning of public facilities including: restrooms, showers, vault toilets, campsites, picnic areas, trails, etc.
- Operates and performs routine maintenance on state owned vehicles and equipment.
- Assures quality customer service and facility maintenance, repair and cleanliness.
- May assist with carpentry, plumbing, masonry, electrical work and transporting materials and supplies.
- Performs other duties as assigned.
- Maintains a working knowledge of and safely operates all of relevant equipment and tools to include tractors, mowers chainsaws power saws, drills, air compressors, generators, and spay equipment ect.
- There are only two positions available in this job class.
- This position is up to 40 hours per week and up to six months in duration.
- The rate of pay for this position is fixed and therefore will not change during the season.
- Hiring and firing is at the supervisor's digression.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:

- Must be at least 18 years of age.
- Must possess and maintain a valid driver's license and a current motor vehicle report.
- Willing to work outside during inclement weather.
- Knowledge of power tool and hand tools preferred.

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- Knowledge of small engine and other equipment maintenance and repair preferred.
- Must be able to work various shifts, weekends and holidays.
- Possess strong interpersonal communication skills.
- Ability to work with little to no supervision

Physical Requirements:

- This position will perform physical activities that require considerable use of your arms and legs and moving your whole body, such as climbing, lifting, balancing, walking, stooping, and handling of materials.
- Must be able to lift 50-75 pounds repeatedly during the course of a single workday
