ARKANSAS HEADWATERS RECREATION AREA
SPECIAL USE AGREEMENT
WALK & WADE FISHING

PURPOSE OF EXHIBIT: To authorize **Company Legal** operating as **Company dba** for the following activities for 2019 within the AHRA:

- Commercially guided walk and wade fishing trips, WITHOUT THE USE OF WATERCRAFT

as detailed in the AHRA Operating and Safety Plan, within the Agreement term, launch windows where applicable, capacities on the Arkansas River and pursuant to the provisions of the Arkansas Headwaters Recreation Area Management Plan (AHRA-MP) and the following Conditions:

CONDITIONS:

1. AHRA Special Use Agreement Application

As an addendum to Condition 1 of the Special Use Agreement, any person or business entity conducting any of the authorized commercial operations listed above shall meet the following requirement(s):

- a. Submit a copy of a current Colorado Outfitters Registration issued by the Office of Outfitter Registration. Required for any Holder involved in the taking of fish on public lands or waters within the State of Colorado. Violation of the terms of the Colorado Outfitters Registration may be cause for Agreement probation, suspension or revocation.
 - 1) All guides must have current first aid and CPR certification cards with a hands-on practical.
- b. Submit a copy of a current Colorado Parks and Wildlife (CPW) Temporary Wildlife Special Use Permit issued by the appropriate Area Wildlife Manager. This is required for any Holder utilizing State Wildlife Areas within the AHRA for commercial operations. Violation of the terms of the CPW Temporary Wildlife Special Use Permit may be cause for Agreement probation, suspension or revocation.

2. Guide ID Cards

- a. AHRA will issue AHRA Guide ID Cards to each Holder based on the number of guides listed in the application package. Each Guide ID Card will have the company name, Agreement number, ID Card number and expiration date displayed.
- b. AHRA Guide ID Cards may only be used by the Holder or any agent or employee of the Holder while conducting commercial operations within the AHRA. It is the responsibility of the Holder to ensure that all AHRA Guide ID Cards are used only for authorized Special Use Agreement activities.
- c. AHRA Guide Cards must be carried at all times by the Holder, any agent, or employee of the Holder while conducting commercial operations within the AHRA. It is the responsibility of the Holder, if the employee should for whatever reason leave the employment prior to the expiration date on the card, to retake possession of the card. AHRA must then be provided an updated Guided List by uploading this information to the ahraoutfitters.org site.

3. No Use / Declaration of Non-Use

- a. No Use shall be defined as a Holder with a Walk and Wade Fishing Agreement who guides zero (0) commercial clients during the term of the Agreement.
- b. Declaration of Non-Use
 - 1) A Declaration of Non-Use must be submitted in writing and received by March 1st. A Holder may petition the AHRA Park Manager for discretionary approval for a Declaration of Non-Use in the event of an unforeseen emergency after the March 1st deadline.
 - 2) All Walk and Wade Fishing Holders declaring a season of non-use must pay \$250.00 [current Minimum Preseason Fee (Application Fee)] by April 1st.
 - 3) The Declaration of Non-Use is non-rescindable and considered approved unless denied by the AHRA Park Manager.
 - 4) The AHRA Park Manager will decide within 10 business days whether to deny the Declaration of Non-Use.
 - 5) If denied, written notice will be given to the Holder making the Declaration of Non-Use by March 15th.
 - 6) A Holder's Agreement will be revoked if that Holder operates commercially within the AHRA after declaring a season of non-use.
- c. A Holder may have either one (1) No Use Season or a Declaration of Non-Use Season once every five (5) years.
- d. Any combination of No Use or a Declaration of Non-Use twice in a five-year period will result in Agreement revocation.
- e. A Holder who has previously had either a no use season or a Declaration of Non-Use in a five-year period may petition the AHRA Park Manager for discretionary approval for a second Declaration of Non-Use in the event of an unforeseen emergency.
