

Cherry Creek Stream Stabilization at 12-Mile Dog Off Leash Area Work Notice

- Where:** Cherry Creek at 12-Mile Dog Off Leash Area
Who: The Cherry Creek Basin Water Quality Authority's contractor (53 Corporation)
What: Stream stabilization using sheet pile and rock materials
Why: Improve water quality and prevent creek erosion from continuing upstream
When: Late April to early August 2022

More Information:

The Cherry Creek Basin Water Quality Authority's (CCBWQA) mission is to improve, protect, and preserve water quality in Cherry Creek Reservoir. CCBWQA is beginning a stream stabilization project on Cherry Creek at the 12-Mile Dog Off Leash Area to prevent channel erosion from continuing upstream into the previously constructed improvements along Cherry Creek including boulder edging, concrete sidewalk, and dedicated access points for park users into Cherry Creek. The work will include metal sheet piling, rock materials, and revegetation to stabilize Cherry Creek. Existing vegetation will be protected as much as possible. Construction access to the stream stabilization site will be along the existing 12-Mile Trail as shown in the image on the right side of this notice. Stabilizing Cherry Creek benefits water quality by reducing sediment (sand) and nutrients (Phosphorus and Nitrogen) from being carried into Cherry Creek Reservoir. We appreciate your understanding as we work to maintain Cherry Creek and continue to offer park users access to Cherry Creek at the Dog Off Leash Area.
