- Maximum 250 users & 250 vehicles
- Beautiful lake & mountain view
- Great for small weddings
- Electrical outlet
- 8 picnic tables & double grill
- Convenient access to parking
- Restrooms



## Reminders

- *Park Passes required for all vehicles*
- *Areas only available from 10 a.m. – 8 p.m.*
- *Reserve early, weekends fill up quickly*
- *Vehicles **must** stay on roadways & lots*
- *Bring a cart for loading & unloading*
- *No guaranteed entry or reserved parking*
- *Surrounding areas & parking open to the public*
- *Bring your volleyball & net setup*
- *Pets must be on 6 foot leash*
- *No glass or pets allowed at beach or Swim Beach Picnic Areas*

## Hobie Hill Shelter

- Small dual shelters on lake's west side
- Near West Boat Ramp and Marina
- Maximum 100 users & 85 vehicles
- Ideal for fishing and boating access
- Two grills and 4 tables
- Electricity & restrooms



## Swim Beach Picnic Areas

- Two adjacent areas, North & South
- Larger groups rent both
- On the beach amongst the trees
- Maximum 50 users & 50 vehicles each
- Great for beach & swim parties
- 5 tables & double grill in each area
- Restrooms & fountain at Bath House
