Table 1. Category Descriptions

Violation	Description
Alcohol	Related to alcohol ranging from driving under the influence to minors with possession.
Camping	Not following camping rules or did not purchase and display reservation.
Dogs	Mostly related to dogs without leash.
Drugs	Marijuana or drug paraphernalia.
Misc.	Various citations, e.g. obstruction of peace officer, violation of protection order.
Park Pass	Failure to obtain or make readily available for inspection an appropriate and valid pass.
State Park Rules	Not following park rules such as littering.
Traffic	Parking and moving violations
Wildlife	Violations of hunting and fishing rules such as fishing without a license. Also not following rules and regulations surrounding hunting, fishing, and wildlife protection.

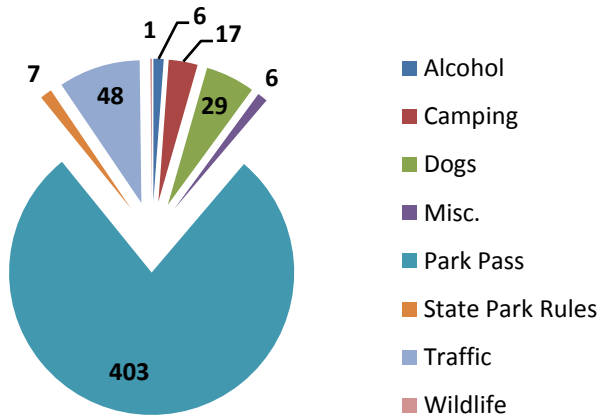


Figure 2. Citations 2007

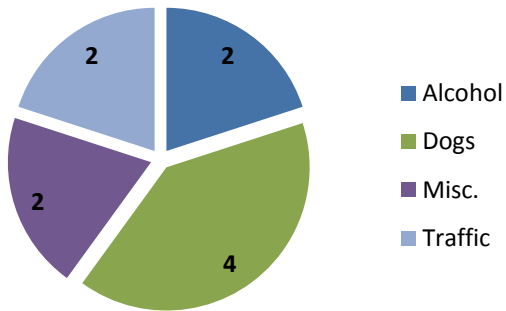


Figure 3. Citations 2008

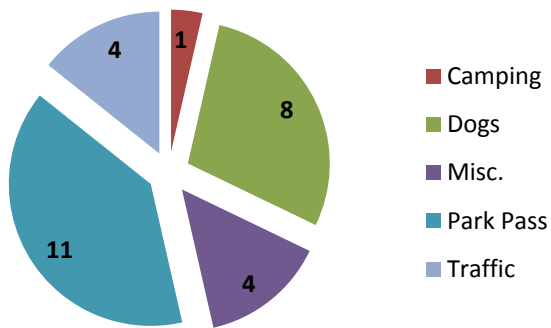


Figure 4. Citations 2009

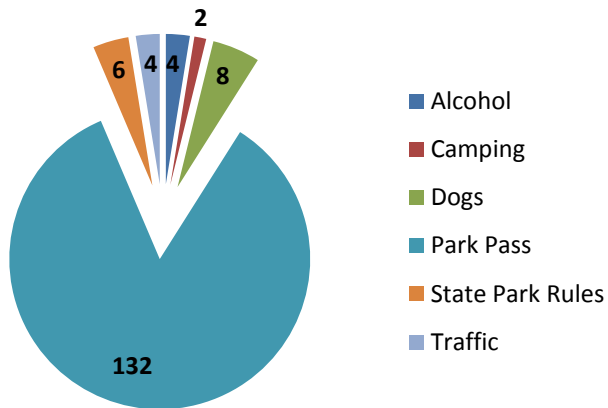


Figure 5. Citations 2010

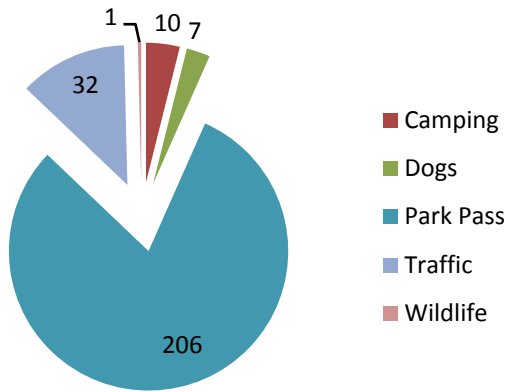


Figure 6. Citations 2011
