**Details:** For **emerging learners** (K-4th grade). Springtime means it’s baby season for wildlife at Cheyenne Mountain State Park! Your Mission, Agent, is to discover new and exciting facts about the baby animals who live in our park with the help of Agent Blackbear—all from the comfort of your home! How do you start?

1. Download the **free Agents of Discovery app** available on the App Store and Google Play to your iOS or Android mobile device.

2. Create a **login**. Once logged in, click **Missions**.

3. Open the “**Explore from Home: Cheyenne Mountain State Park’s Spring Babies!**” mission. (You may need to use the search bar; tap the magnifying glass and search “Cheyenne Mountain State Park”)

4. On a computer or another device, open this page to see the **image triggers** (on the following pages). *To get the kids up and active, we recommend you print the image triggers and place them around the house or backyard!*

5. In the Mission, tap each **Challenge** icon, hold up your phone and scan the correct image to unlock the Challenge. Then, learn and have fun as you play each challenge and complete your mission!!
