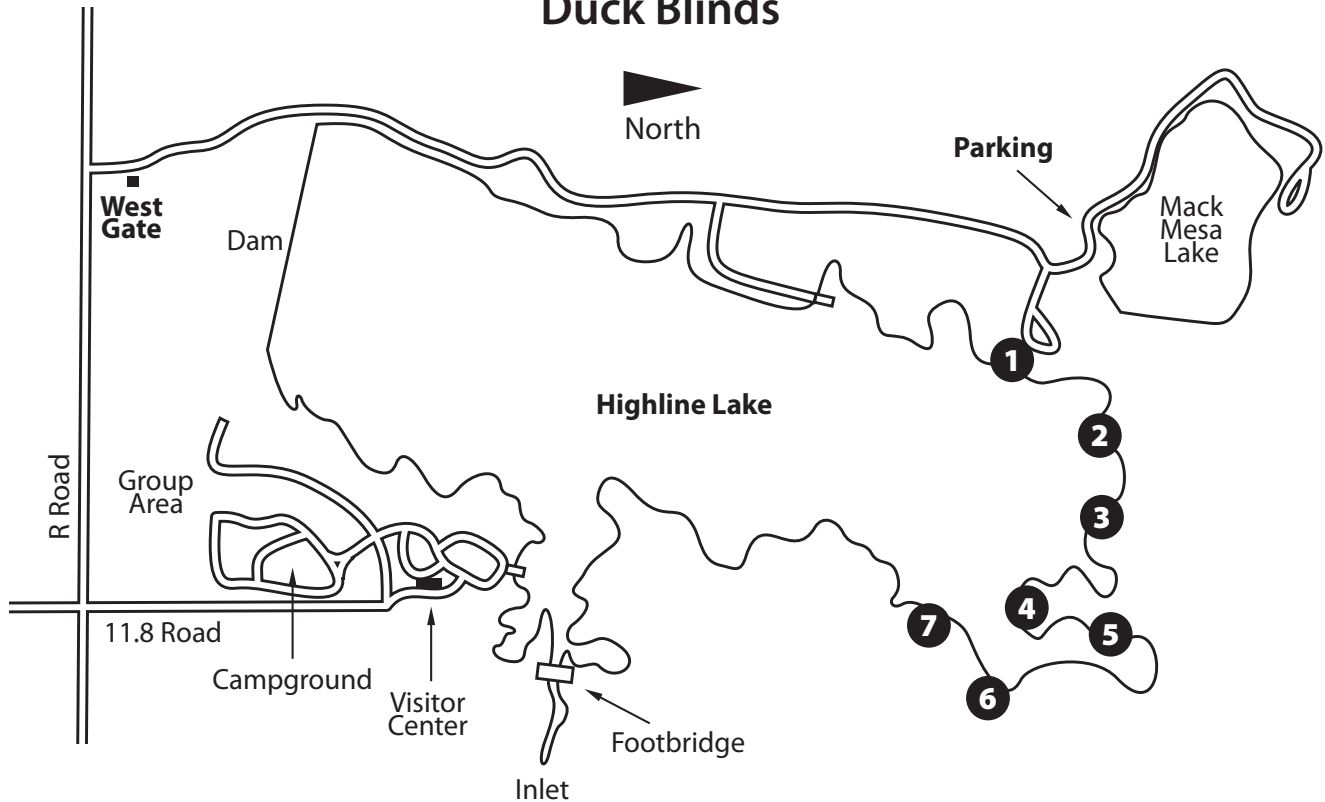


Highline Lake State Park Duck Blinds



Hunting at Highline

- Waterfowl hunting only.
- Hunting must be from blinds.
- Hand-propelled boats allowed for deployment of decoys and bird retrieval only. Shooting from a boat is prohibited.
- Monday through Friday only. No weekend hunting at Highline.
- Maximum four hunters per blind.
- If no reservation exists for a blind, hunters may check in on a first-come-first-served basis after 5:00 am the day of the hunt.
- Reserved areas not claimed by 7:00 am will be available on a first-come-first-served basis, but must be yielded if the hunters with the reservation show up.

Reservation Procedures

- Call **(970) 255-6161** to make a reservation.
- Reservations are free of charge, but a valid State Parks vehicle pass is required to enter the park.
- Reservations not accepted more than 14 days in advance.
- Reservations must be made before Noon on the day before your hunt. For holidays falling on a Monday, reservations must be made before Noon on the previous Friday.
- Only one reservation per hunt date per phone call.
- Reservations are non-transferrable.
- Hunters must have valid licenses for the species to be hunted.
- Hunters must observe all Colorado hunting regulations. Get a copy from your local sporting goods store, any State Parks visitor center, or any State Wildlife office.
- You must be present on the property the day of your reservation and follow check-station procedures as posted at the park, or lose reservation rights for the remainder of the hunting season.
