

MUELLER STATE PARK

RENTAL CABIN GUIDELINGS & REGULATIONS

Check-In/Check-out Time

- **Check-in time is 4:00 pm; Checkout time is 12:00 noon**

Please inspect your cabin and make sure it is in satisfactory condition. Any concerns or damage should be reported to the campground entrance station, visitor center or to a park ranger before you leave the park.

- [Pine Cabin](#) - 4 people /any age (2 bedrooms)
- [Spruce Cabin](#) - 6 people /any age (3 bedrooms)
- [Ponderosa Cabin](#) - 8 people / any age (4 bedrooms)

Please Note:

- Bed mattresses are queen size.
- Maximum occupancy is strictly enforced due to fire codes.

Handicap Accessibility

- [Pine Cabin](#) - This cabin is not wheelchair accessible (very narrow areas).
- [Spruce Cabin](#) - The upper level of this cabin is wheelchair accessible.
- [Ponderosa Cabin](#) - This cabin is wheelchair accessible.

Parking

Parking is available adjacent to each cabin. No additional tent/trailer/RV use is allowed on the cabin grounds. Each vehicle must have a valid Daily Parks Pass or Colorado State Park Annual Pass.

- [Pine Cabin](#) - 2 cars maximum
- [Spruce Cabin](#) - 3 cars maximum
- [Ponderosa Cabin](#) - 3 cars maximum

Responsible Party

The person making the reservation is responsible for the group's conduct.

Clean-up and Trash Removal

Please read and follow the checkout instructions contained in the information notebook in each cabin.

Pets are Prohibited

Pets are not permitted in the cabins (including parking areas, yards, etc.).

Smoking/Marijuana Use

All smoking and marijuana use is prohibited in the cabins.

GUEST INFORMATION

Cooking

Kitchens are equipped with electric coffee pot, toaster, refrigerator, stoves/ovens and microwaves are provided. Dishes, silverware, pots and pans and cooking utensils are all provided.

- Please note: specialty items such as roasting pans, glass bake ware, trivets, blenders, hand mixing, and wine glasses, etc. are not provided; you are welcome to bring your own.

Outdoor entertaining is made easy with an outdoor gas barbecue grill; however outdoor fire pits are not provided.

Drinking Water

The cabins are equipped with running water safe for consumption. As an added convenience, you will find an ice maker in the refrigerator.

Heating & Electricity

A forced air furnace and a gas fireplace heat the cabins. Please help us conserve energy. Turn the thermostat down and turn lights off when you are not in the cabin and when you checkout.

Laundry

Coin operated laundry facilities are available at the Camper Services Building (mid-May thru mid-Oct) or in Woodland Park.

Linens/Towels and Furnishings

One set of linens and towels will be provided for your stay. Replacement linens and towels will be provided for stays longer than 5 days. Please do not move furniture or beds around in the cabins.

Restrooms

All restrooms provide a toilet, sink and shower, allowing you to enjoy the comforts of home away from home. Please remember to bring your own toiletries: facial tissue, shower soap, shampoo/conditioner and hair dryer.

Emergencies

Emergency procedures and contact information are available in the information notebook in each cabin.

Items To Bring

- Confirmation letter with entrance code
- Personal toiletries: facial tissue, shower soap, shampoo/conditioner and hair dryer
- Food including salt, pepper and other cooking spices
- Specialty cooking items: roasting pans, glass bake ware, trivets, blenders, hand mixing, and wine glasses, etc.
- Clothing
- Hiking/snow gear
- Toys/games for the kids
