

## Large Cabin #1



This large cabin will comfortably house your entire family. It sleeps up to 12 people, and features three bedrooms, a bathroom and a full kitchen. Two night minimum stay required.

### Large Cabin Amenities

- Limited solar lighting, no electricity
- Heat
- Bedroom 1: queen mattress
- Bedrooms 2 & 3: two sets of bunk beds each (total of 8 singles)
- Futon in living room
- Two recliners
- Table and chairs with seating for eight;
- Kitchen with propane stove/oven and refrigerator;
- Basic cooking utensils, plates and dinnerware
- Bathroom with sink, flush toilet and shower (year-round)
- Universally accessible outdoor picnic table, fire ring and grill.

## Camper Cabins



Eight Camper Cabins are located five miles up West Brush Creek from the Visitor Center. The camper cabins are available to rent year-round and will sleep up to six people.

Cabins 2, 3, 4 & 5 face the lake for easy fishing access. Cabins 2 & 3 are one room cabins; Cabins 4 & 5 are divided into sleeping and living areas. Cabins 6, 7, 8, & 9 are tucked into the pines for privacy. Cabins 6 & 8 are one room cabins; Cabins 7 & 9 are divided into sleeping and living areas. Pets are allowed in Cabins 2 & 8 for an additional fee per night.



### All guests should bring:

- Bedding, such as sleeping bags or blankets and pillows
- Lantern or flashlight
- Cook stove and cooking utensils for outdoor cooking
- Appropriate clothing for outdoor activities
- Food (**Water if you're staying in a Yurt**)



## Camper Cabin Amenities

- Limited solar lighting; no electricity
- Propane heat
- One full size bed and three twin bunk beds with mattresses
- One fold-out cot
- Table and chairs
- Cupboard and shelves for storage
- Universally accessible outdoor picnic table, fire ring and grill
- Outdoor vault toilet
- Drinking water from nearby hydrant
- Access to the camper services building with flush toilets and coin showers mid-May through mid-October.



## Yurts



Those looking to get away from the busy lake and campground may want to consider one of our three yurts, which sleep up to six people. Yurts are round, tent-like structures with wooden flooring. Our yurts are located 4 1/2 miles up East Brush Creek in a wooded area across from the creek. They are nine miles from the lake. These provide a perfect base camp for fishing, hiking and other access to the White River National Forest. Pets are welcome in Yurt #3 for an additional fee per night.



## Yurt Amenities

- Propane heat
- Limited solar lighting; no electricity
- Storage cupboard
- Two futons and one bunk bed (2 singles)
- Table and four chairs
- Outdoor, universally accessible picnic table, fire ring and grill
- Outdoor bear-proof food locker
- Outdoor vault toilet
- Flush toilets and coin showers available at Sylvan Lake Campground mid-May to mid-October (9 miles)
- Yurt 1 is closest to parking and bathroom  
Yurt 3 is furthest from parking and bathroom.
