INSURANCE

Insurance is required unless waived. The responsible person / event coordinator will submit a certificate of insurance indicating insurance coverage in the minimum amounts of \$990,000 per occurrence /\$350,000.00 personal injury, as specified in 24-10-114, C.R.S. The certificate must list Boyd Lake State Park and Colorado Parks and Wildlife as an additional insured party. Early submission of insurance is recommended.

I understand that I am the responsible party for this event staying within compliance with all State Statutes, Regulations and conditions of this agreement, including those conditions listed below. Violations may result in citations, eviction or loss of future use of Boyd Lake State Park. By checking the below boxes below, I agree to the following conditions.

- A valid park pass is required on all vehicles unless arrangements for alternative fees have been approved.
- No implied rights or reservations are granted for camping or parking spaces. Park admission is on a first come, first served basis. Entry to the park may be prohibited when the park is at capacity. Exceptions are not made for special events.
- All participants in the event agree to abide by and obey all Colorado State Parks rules and regulations, and any other regulations that may apply.
- All temporary signs, banners, buoys, and markers are to be placed only with prior approval and removed at the conclusion of the event.
- Approval of this event does not imply that extra services will be provided, nor does it place any additional liabilities upon Colorado State Parks or Boyd Lake State Park.
- The permittee agrees to provide public notification of the event should park staff deem it necessary.
- The permittee agrees to hold harmless Colorado State Parks, Boyd Lake State Park, and park staff from any death, injury, or property damage occurring as a result of the event.
- The permittee shall supply all necessary personnel and equipment to safely conduct this event and shall be responsible for any damage to park resources and/or facilities that result from this event.
- Permittee will get prior approval from the park for any activity related to alcohol and ensure all proper liquor licenses are obtained from State of Colorado and Larimer County.
- Colorado Parks and Wildlife maintains the right to amend or cancel this permit at any time should the permittee fail to abide by conditions agreed to or if public health, safety and welfare so dictate.
- The permittee may be assessed additional fees for the event. Payment is due prior to the event unless other arrangements have been approved.
