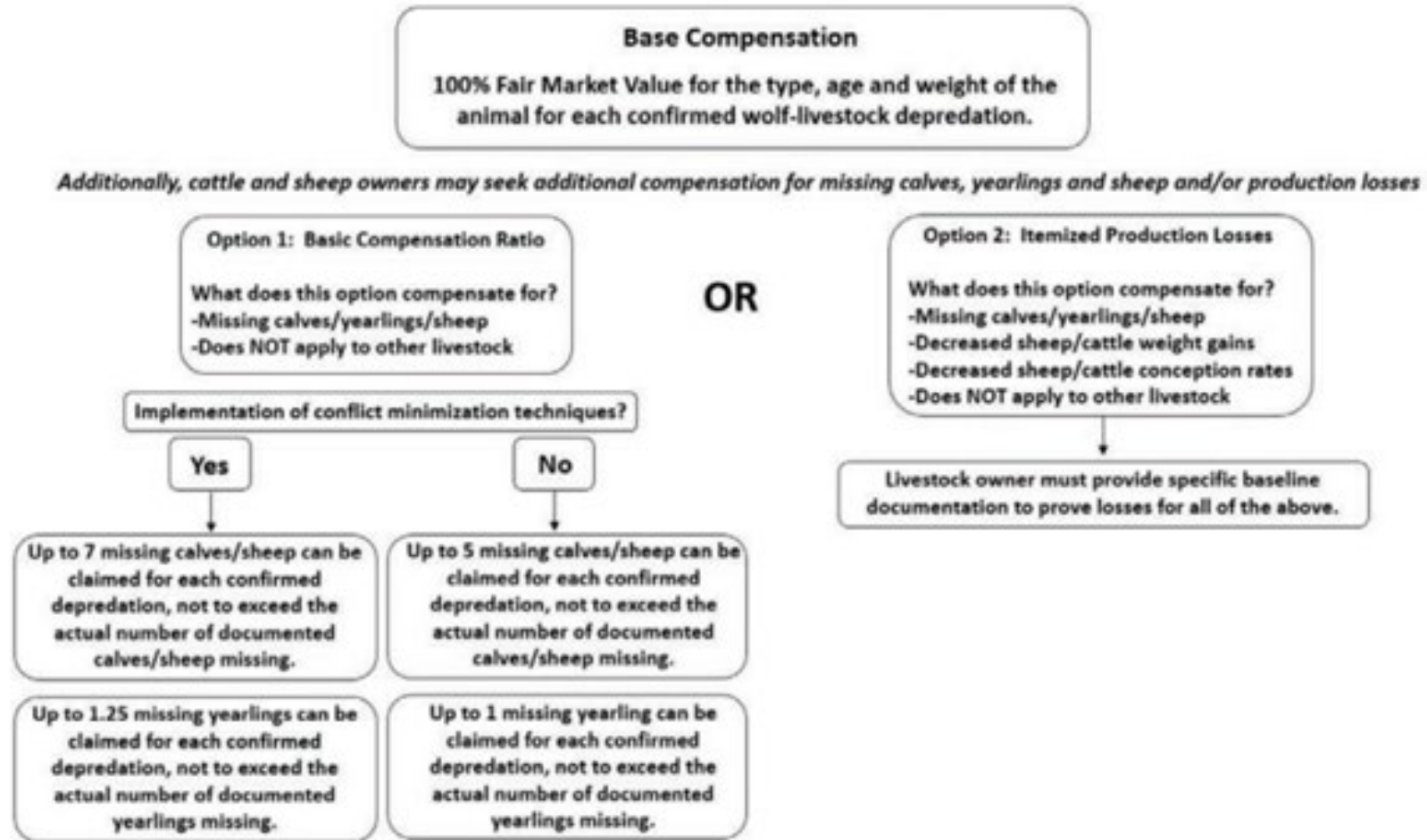
Reverse JL Bar's 2025 claims

- Portions of the itemized claim that the Division recommends paying:
 - Missing cattle: \$16,041.89
 - Reduced weights: \$34,265.08
 - Reduced conception rates: \$40,863.60
- Total = \$91,170.57

- Portion of the claim that the Division recommends denying
 - Late-bred cows: \$34,094.71

The following flow chart provides a visual representation of options available under this compensation program:

Reduced conception rates

A producer may be compensated for “decreased conception rates . . . to the extent of the difference between the claimant's current, allegedly reduced . . . rates relative to the average of such . . . rates for the three years preceding the first Confirmed Wolf Depredation.

Reduced weights

Reduced conception rates

Delayed conception
