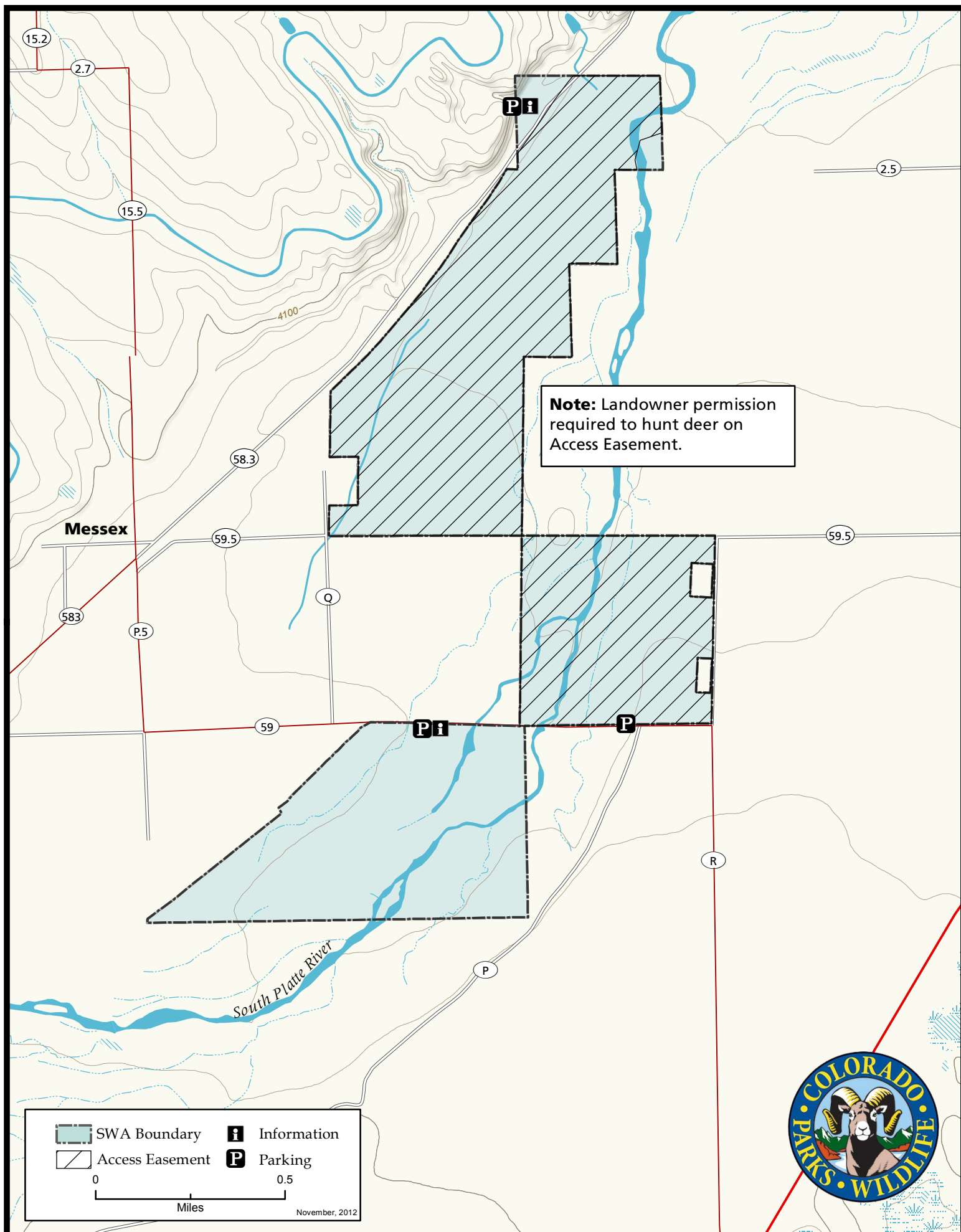
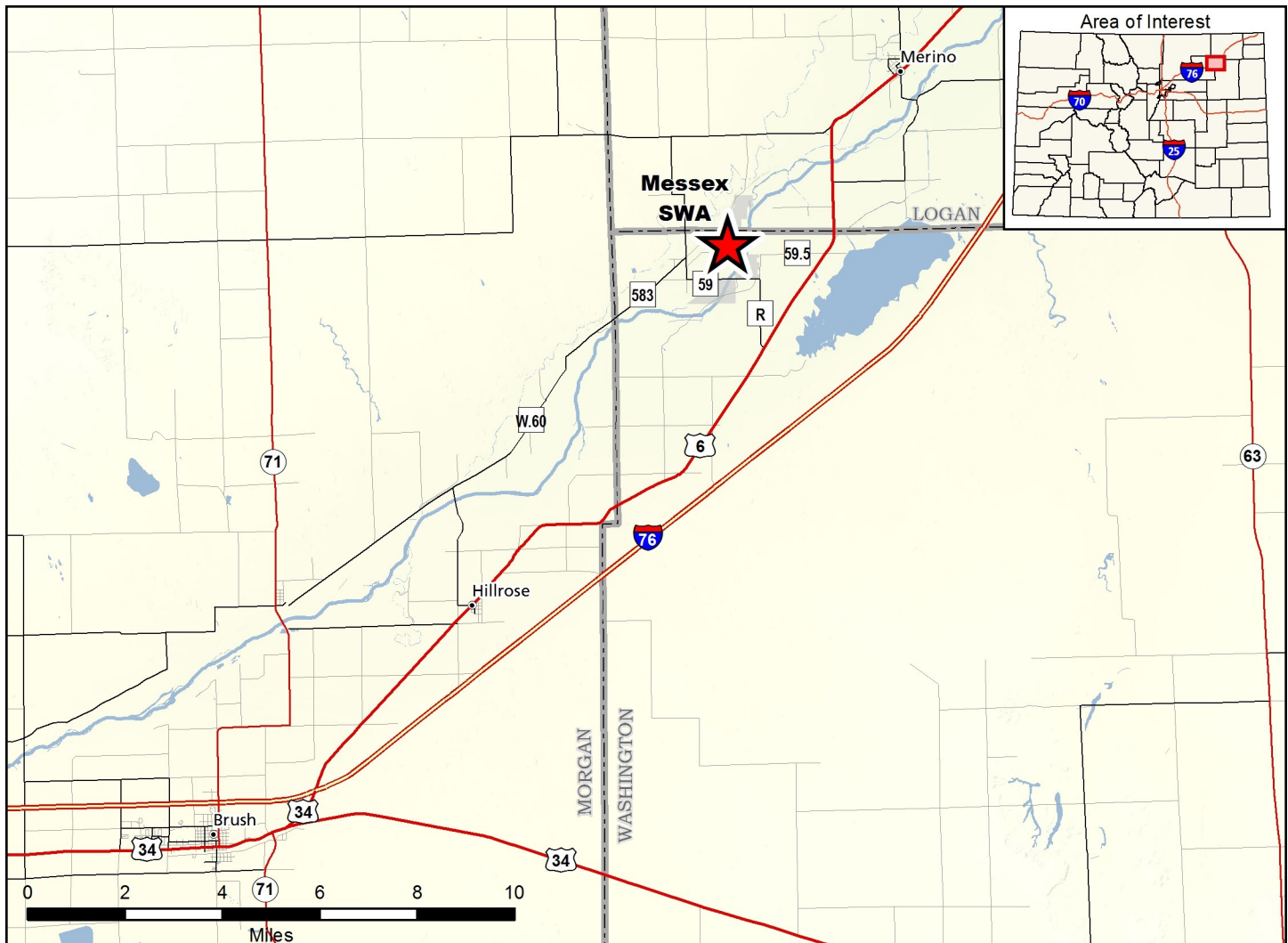


Messex State Wildlife Area





Messex SWA - Washington & Logan Counties

From Interstate 76 at the Merino exit (exit 102), go 2 miles north to Highway 6, then 1 3/4 miles east (right) to County Road R, then 1 1/2 miles north (left) to County Road 59, and then 1/2 mile west (left) to parking areas located at the bridge. To reach the Skaggs portion, go 2 miles west from the parking areas on County Road 59 to County Road P.5, then 1/2 mile north (right) to an unmarked gravel road on the north side of the railroad tracks, and then 1 1/4 miles northeast (right) to the parking area.

Wildlife Area Offers:

Hunting: Deer, Pheasant, Turkey, Quail, Waterfowl (GMU 96)

Recreation: Hunting, Wildlife Viewing

C. Landowner permission required to hunt deer on access easement.

D. The launching or takeout of vessels is prohibited during waterfowl seasons.

Regulations:

In addition to or in place of those restrictions listed in regulation #900 the below listed provisions or restrictions apply (see Ch. 9, <http://cpw.state.co.us/aboutus/Pages/Regulations.aspx>).

- A. Public access is prohibited from 9:00 p.m. – 4:00 a.m.
- B. All recreational activities, except deer hunting, are prohibited on the opening weekend of the regular plains rifle deer season and on the opening day and first weekend of the late plains rifle deer season.
