- Traditionally-excluded communities served include: Black, Indigenous, and people of color; LGBTQ+; people with disabilities; and low-income

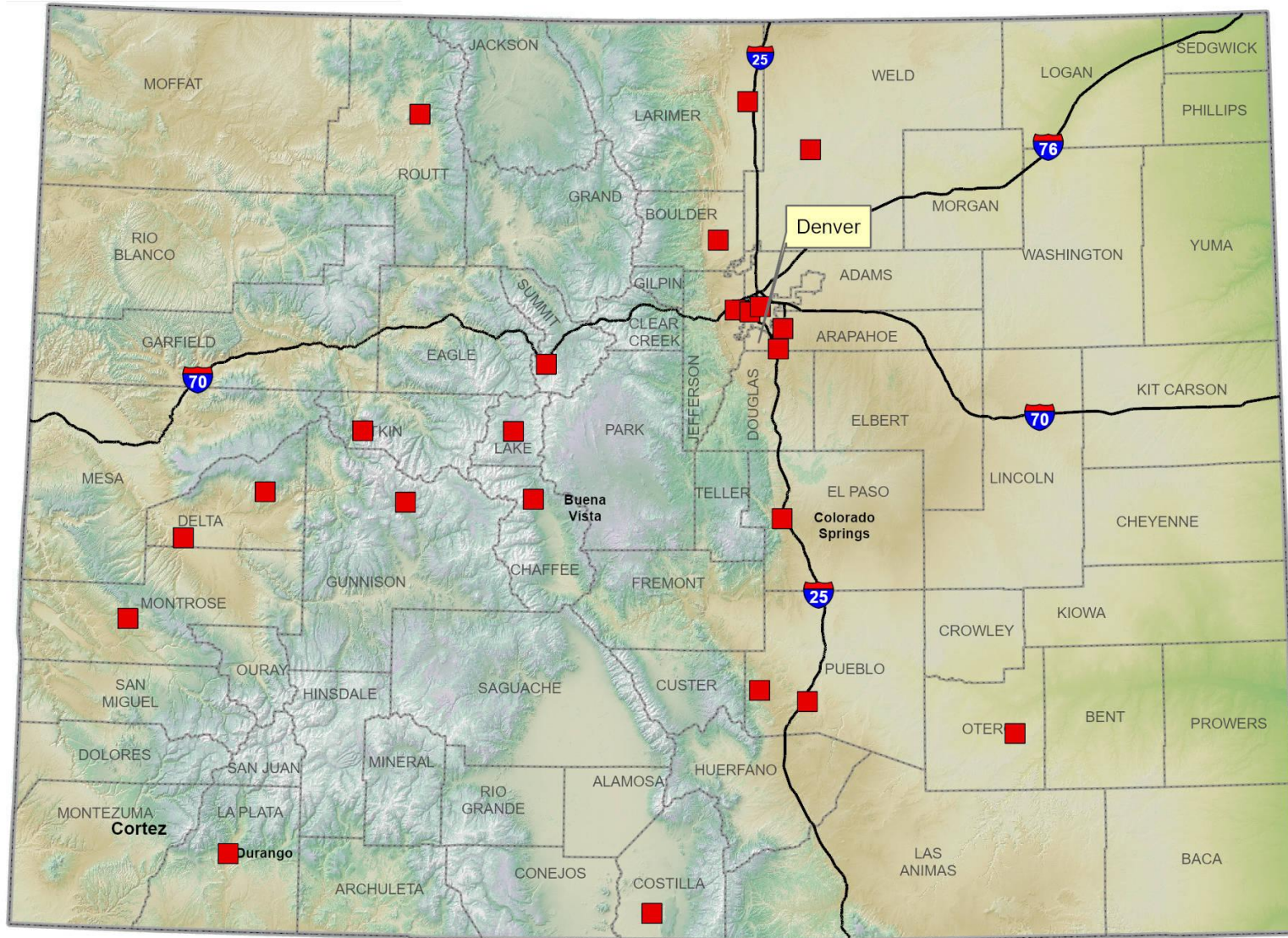
FY25 Grant Awards

- 24 awards
- \$100,000 maximum request
- \$83,000 average grant award
- 10 new organizations
- 41 counties invested in
- 245 grant proposals totaling \$20M (10% funded)



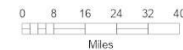

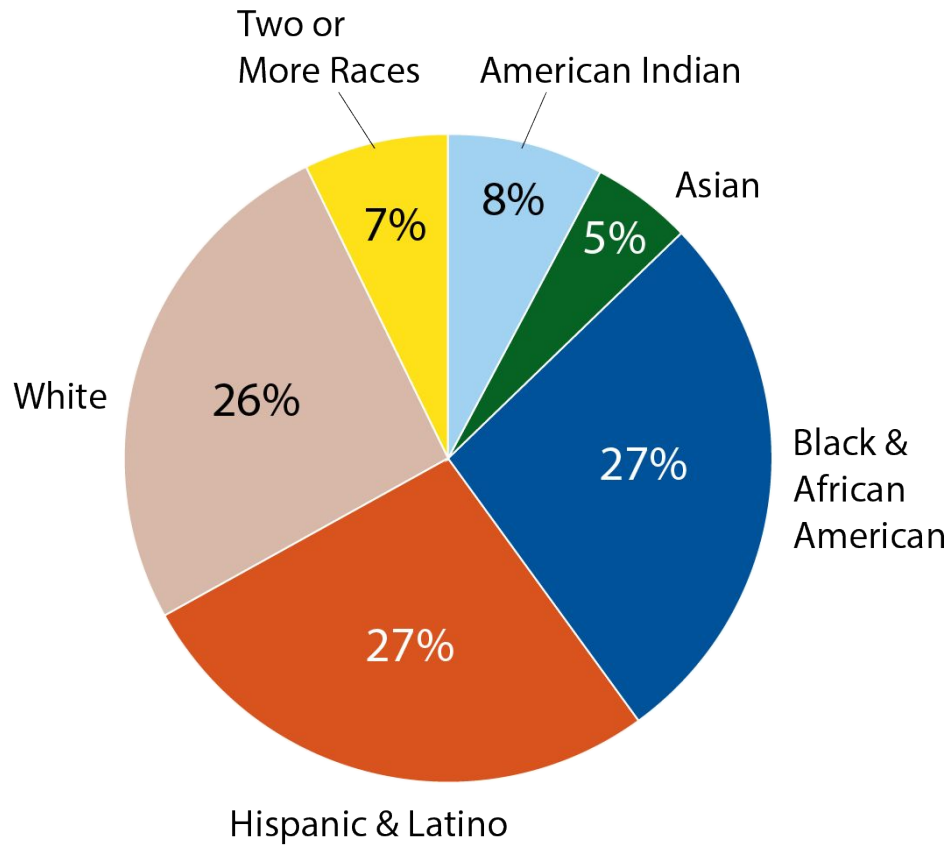

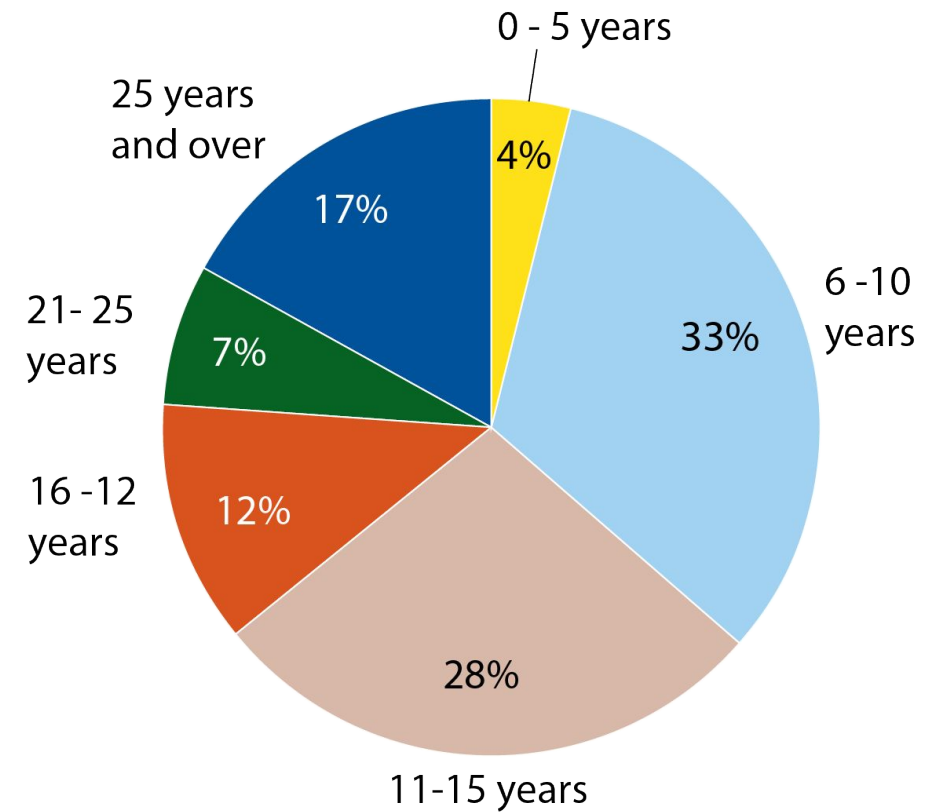
