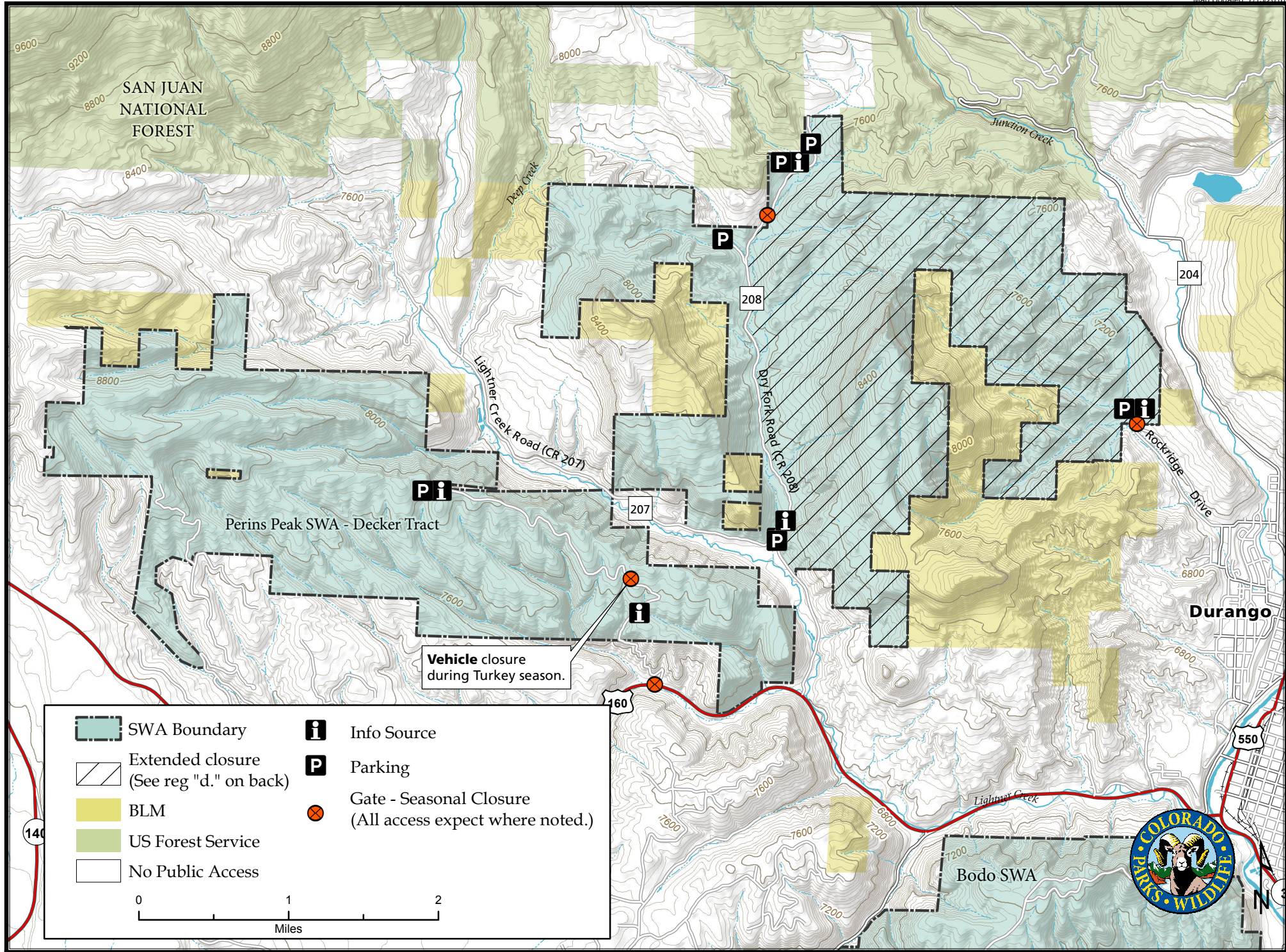
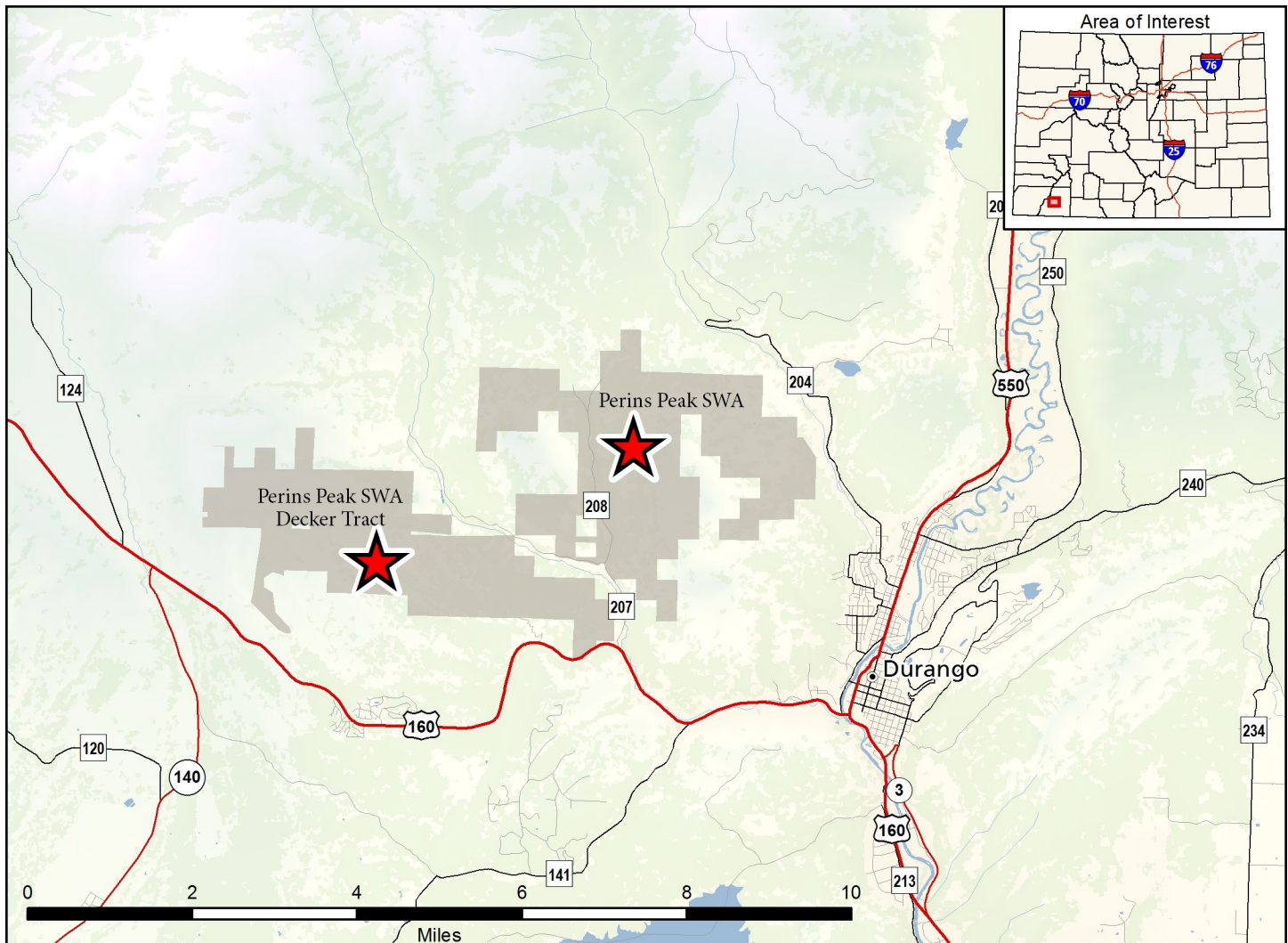


# Perins Peak State Wildlife Area

### Perins Peak SWA - La Plata County

From Durango, go 4 miles W on Hwy. 160 to CR 207 (Lightner Creek Rd.); turn right and go 2 miles N to CR 208 (Dry Fork Rd.). Decker Tract: From Durango, go 5 miles W on Hwy. 160 to Victory Coal Mine Rd.; turn right and go a half-mile on access road (through private property).

#### Wildlife Area Offers:

Hunting: Deer, Elk, Rabbit, Squirrel,  
(GMU 74) Dusky (blue) Grouse, Turkey, Black Bear

#### Regulations:

*In addition to or in place of those restrictions listed in regulation #900 the below listed provisions or restrictions apply (see Ch. 9, <http://cpw.state.co.us/aboutus/Pages/Regulations.aspx>).*

- Public access is prohibited west of La Plata County Road 208 from December 1 through April 30, except turkey hunters.
- Public access is prohibited east of La Plata Co Rd 208 from December 1 through July 31.
- Camping is allowed by licensed hunters during an established big game season plus three (3) days before and three (3) days after each season.

- Discharge of firearms or bows is prohibited, except while hunting.
- Snowmobile use is prohibited.
- Dogs are allowed but must be kept under control on a physical leash by the handler at all times from May 1 through September 30 west of CR 208 and from August 1 through September 30 east of CR 208, except as authorized in #900(C)(15).
- Dogs are allowed pursuant to #900(C)(15) from October 1 through November 30.
