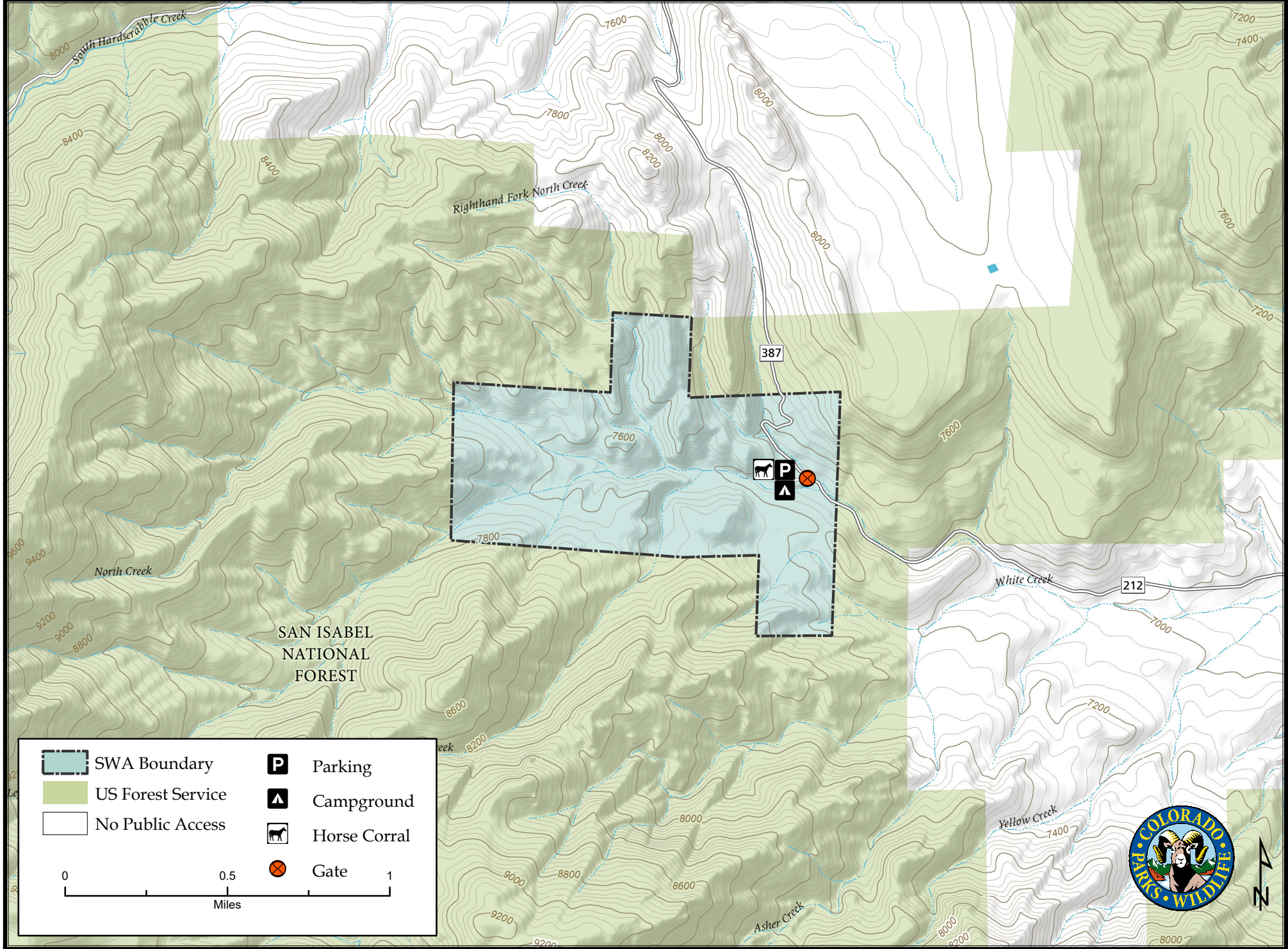
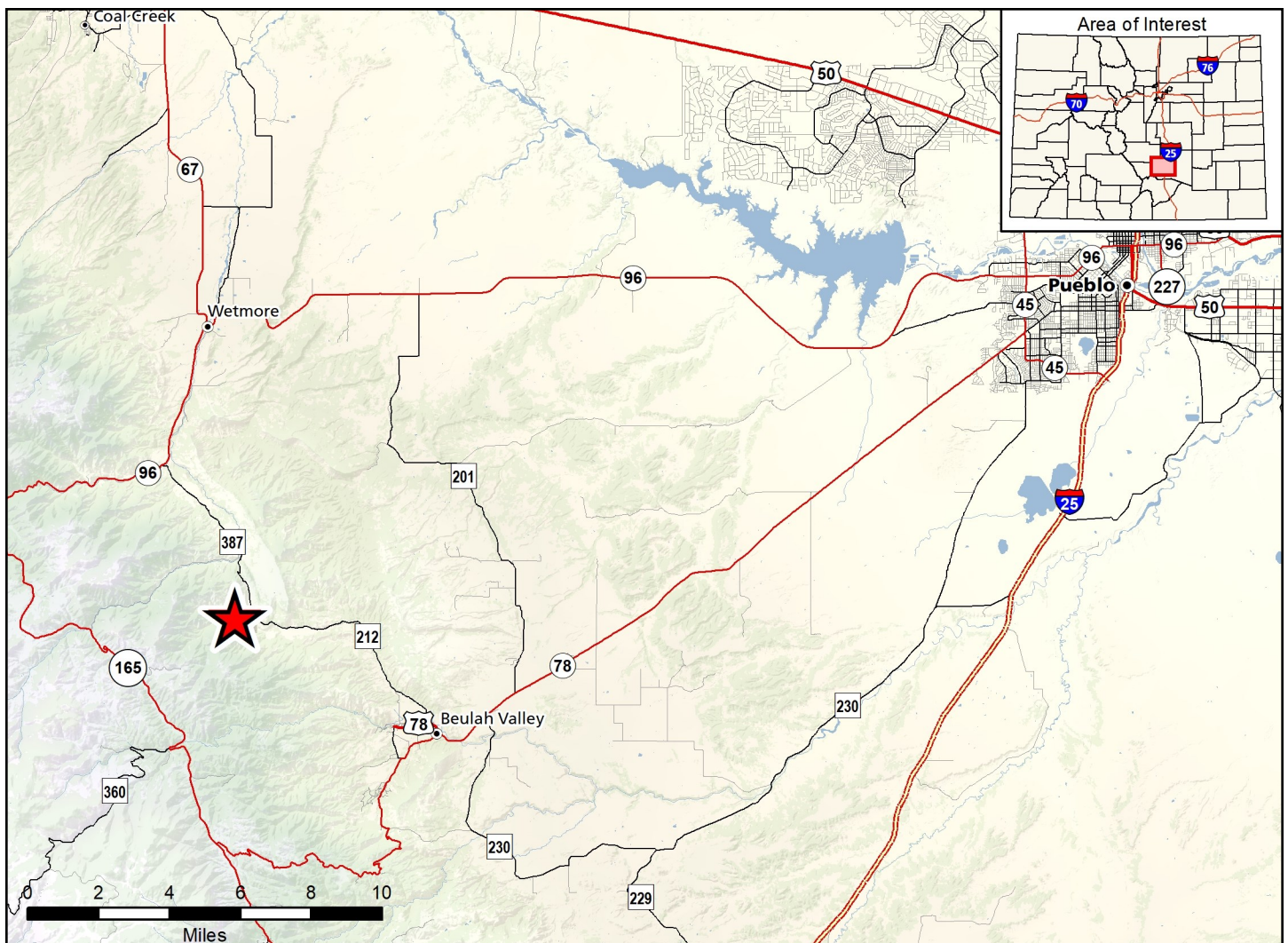


Upper Red Cliff State Wildlife Area

Upper Red Cliff Ranch SWA - Custer County

From Pueblo, travel W on Hwy. 78 for 20 miles to Central Ave. within the Beulah Valley. Turn right on North Creek Rd. (CO Rd. 387) and travel 6.7 miles to the property entrance.

Wildlife Area Offers:

Fishing: Coldwater stream and ponds
 Hunting: elk, deer, bear, mountain lion, turkey, dusky grouse
 Recreation: Wildlife Viewing

- C. Discharging firearms or bows allowed only while hunting.
- D. Camping allowed by licensed hunters during big game or turkey season plus 3 days before and 3 days after each season. Camping prohibited within 100 feet of any stream.
- E. Dog training and field trials prohibited.

Regulations:

In addition to or in place of those restrictions listed in regulation #900 the below listed provisions or restrictions apply (see Ch. 9, <http://cpw.state.co.us/aboutus/Pages/Regulations.aspx>).

- A. Public access prohibited Dec. 1–April 30, except for licensed hunters and one nonhunting companion. Hunting by reservation only. See “Reservations: Hunting” (page 1) for details.
- B. Parking and access allowed from designated parking areas only.
