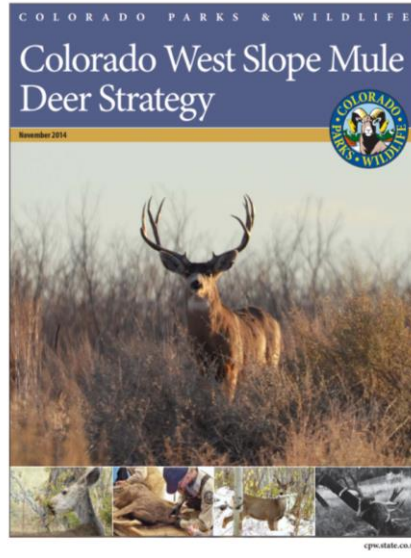
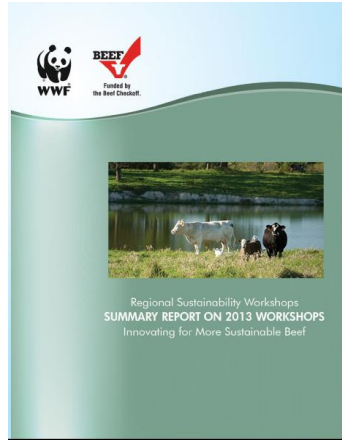

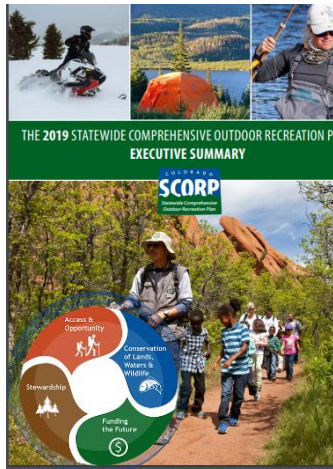
### Sustainable Alternative Proposed for the Management of Browns Canyon National Monument



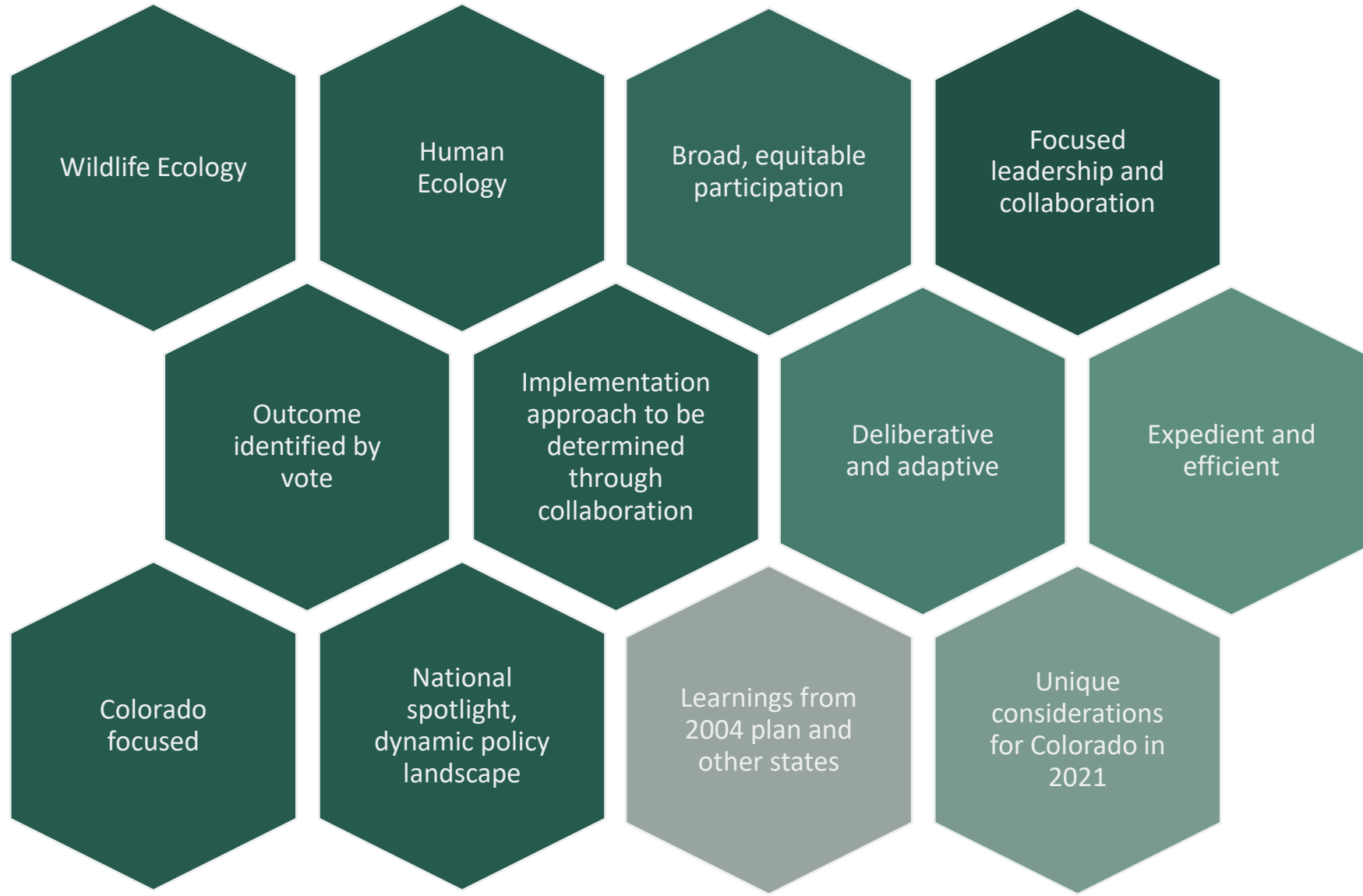

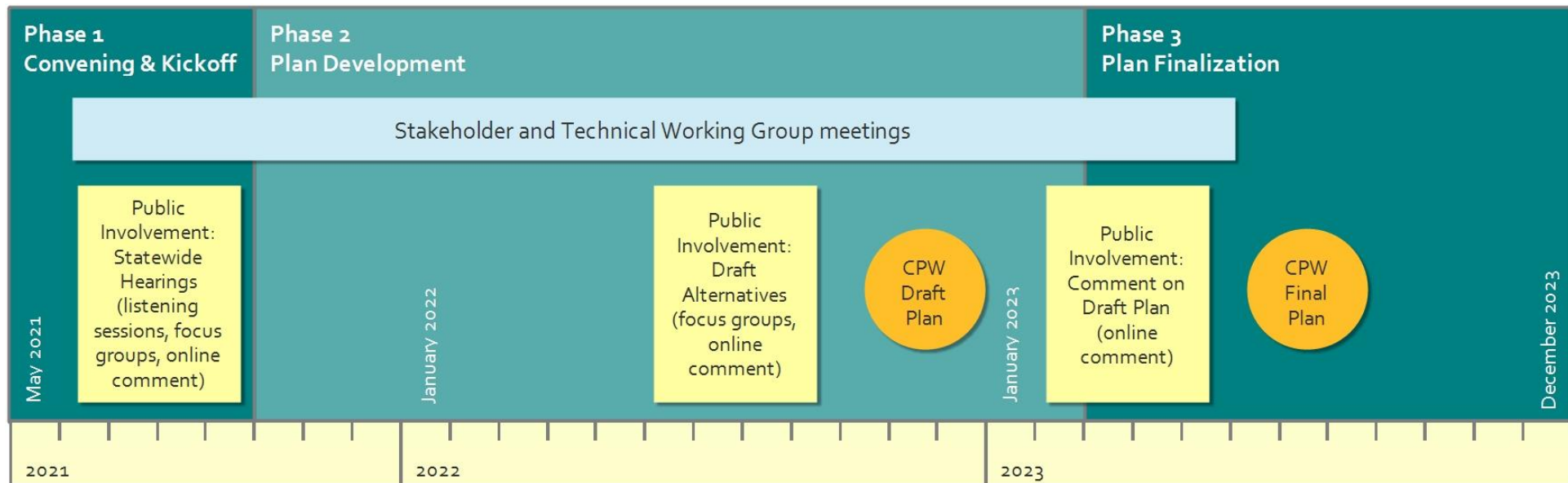

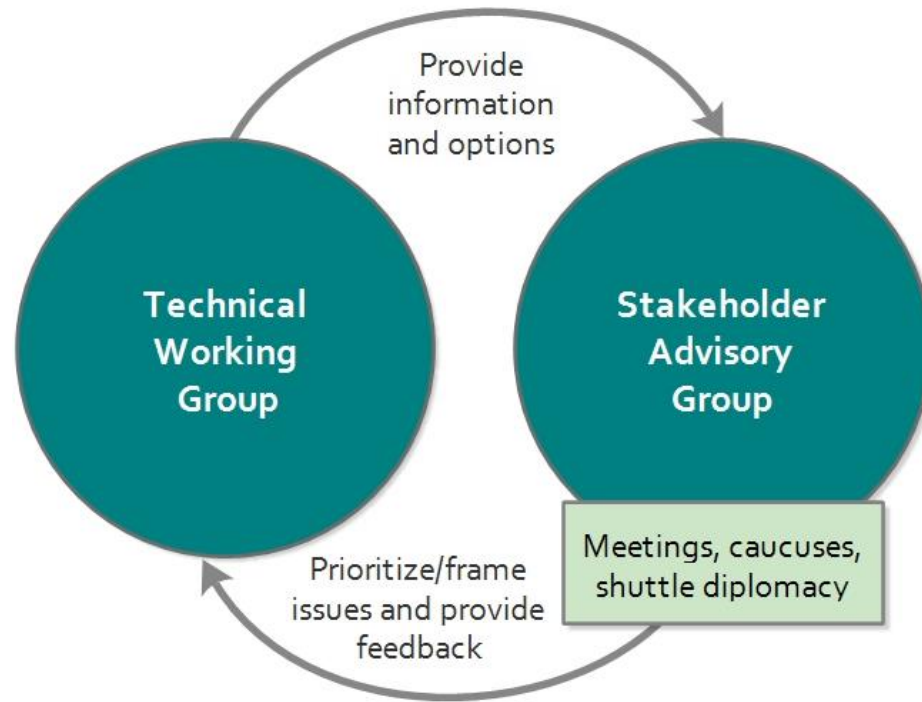


# Draft Approach: Public Involvement
